
Displacement in the municipality of Tabarre (West District)

The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to collect information on large and sudden population movements as well as security and climatic emergencies. Information is collected through phone interviews with key informants and direct observation.

Event Summary

Since 08 December 2023, armed clashes have broken out in the municipality of Tabarre, particularly in the nieghborhoods of HT Monquette, Truitier, Tapage and Dumornay.

These clashes caused the displacement of approximately 317 households (1,240 individuals).

These neighborhoods had suffered attacks in July 2023 (see ETT 20) and later experienced a relative lull inciting some people to return there. These people have therefore just been displaced again.


Nearly half of these people (48%) took refuge in the site of Jean Marie Vincent which was created following the attacks of July 2023. This site had 923 people before the arrival of newly displaced people and now hosts 1,523 people with the latest arrivals.
