




Triggered by clashes between armed groups in Tripoli since 27 August at least 2,045 families (approximately 10,225 individuals) have been displaced to Zliten, Bani Waleed, Misrata, Qasr Akhyar, Tarhouna and safer areas in Tripoli, including 211 families displaced in the last two days. Displaced households originate mostly from conflict-affected neighborhoods, including Ain Zara, Abu Slim, Salah Eddin, Ben Aoun and Khallat Al Furjan.

The majority of displaced households are staying with family in private accommodation, however approximately 100 families were temporarily sheltered in four schools in Tripoli and Janzour, in urgent need of humanitarian assistance. Priority needs in the schools included food, NFIs, health interventions and sanitation.
