OVERVIEW

On 1 January 2024, non-state armed group (NSAG) reportedly attacked Gatawarwa Town in Gatamarwa ward of Chibok LGA in Borno State. The attack affected 114 individuals. As a result of the attack, 12 fatalities and 16 injuries were reported.

On 7 January 2024, NSAG reportedly attacked Kwapre in Garaha ward of Hong LGA of Adamawa State. The attack affected 1,952 individuals and displaced 530 individuals to the communities of Thabu and Cross River in Thilbang ward and 1,322 individuals to the communities of Kwabaktina, Kukurpu and Waje in Hong ward of Hong LGA. As a result of the attack, three fatalities and 30 injuries were recorded.

NEEDS

Amongst the most urgent needs identified were food, shelter, security, non-food items (NFI), WASH, health, education and MHPSS.




Fig. 1. Gender breakdown of affected population





Fig. 2. Most needed assistance
