


#### April 2023 observations

- O Floods, accidents, drought, landslides and heavy winds accompanied by hailstorms were the major hazard events reported in the month of April.
- O The disasters affected a total of 19,311 individuals, representing 3,857 households while 552 individuals from 394 households were internally displaced.
- O Adults (19-64 years) were the most affected population group (61%), followed by children under 18 years (31%) and the elderly who are above 64 years (8%).
- O The most pressing needs are water supply, health and food
- O 212 individuals were injured, 527 houses were completely destroyed, 98 water facilities damaged and 3 health facilities were damaged.
- O There is notable increase of effects of disasters on the population from January to April. This brings the total number of individuals affected in 2023 to 31,287.
