
# Village Assessment Survey

WAU Preliminary findings.


**VAS/FIS** Dataset

Between September 23th and October 19th, 2023, IOM's Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) conducted a Village Assessment Survey (VAS) in Wau County, Western Bahr el Ghazal. The survey aimed to support planning for transition and recovery programs by mapping the availability of basic needs, services, and infrastructures. The VAS data collection was successfully completed in five payams (Bagari, Beselia, Kpaile, Wau North, Wau South) and forty two Bomas within Wau County. However, three bomas, including Hai Jadid, Gittan and Rafili, were not assessed due to either being deserted or poor road conditions

## Staff working at health facilities



Out of the 42 assessed Bomas, there are 29 functioning health facilities and only three hospitals. However, 15 Bomasdo not have any health facilities.




