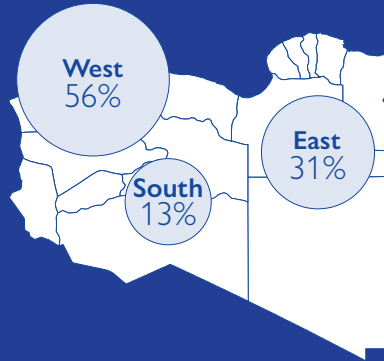

**DTM** DISPLACEMENT TRACKING MATRIX

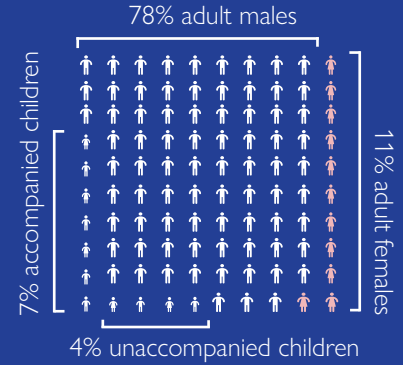

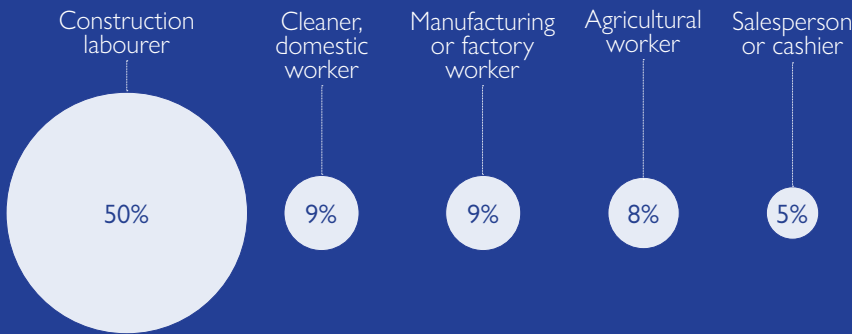

## TOP 5 JOBS OF MIGRANTS IN LIBYA



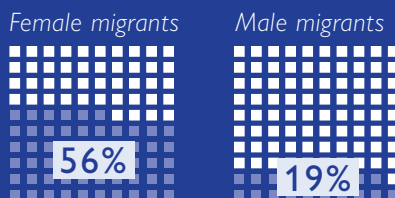

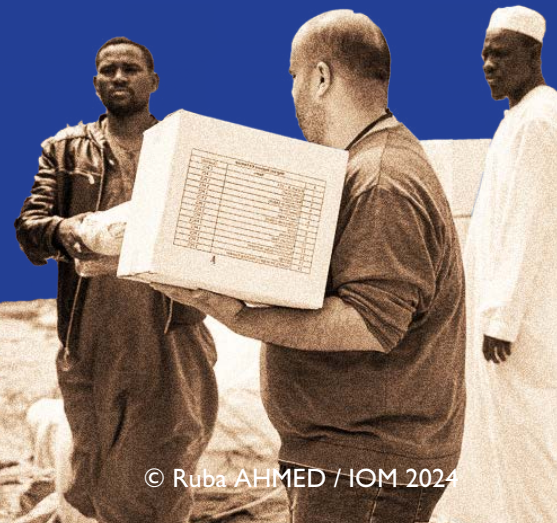
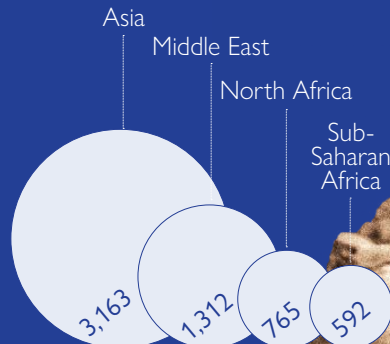
