1. INTRODUCTION



BACKGROUND: POPULATION MOBILITY AND INTERNAL DISPLACEMENT IN ETHIOPIA

Ethiopia ranks on the International Rescue Committee's 2024 Emergency Watchlist as drought-stricken communities face the twin threats of conflict and the likelihood of El Niño-induced flooding. Although the ceasefire between the government and the Tigray People's Liberation Front (TPLF) continues to hold in northern Ethiopia, insecurity in the country persists, exacerbating humanitarian needs and heightening the risk of a resurgence of large-scale conflict¹.

In early November 2020, the regional party of Tigray allegedly attacked the Northern Command of Ethiopia's National Defense Force in Mekelle, Tigray region, prompting a military offensive from the federal government of Ethiopia. Armed clashes between the Tigray People's Liberation Front (TPLF) and the Ethiopian federal forces erupted in the Tigray region, leading to significant displacement. The fighting spread to neighboring Afar and Amhara regions in mid-2021, displacing hundreds of thousands of people. In June 2021, the TPLF regained control of most of Tigray after a unilateral ceasefire by the federal government. However, violence resumed in August 2022 and lasted until 2 November 2022, when a cessation of hostilities was signed between the two parties². As of May 2024, Tigray region hosted the highest number of IDPs displaced by conflict nationwide (an estimated 871,056 individuals or 38.3% of the national conflict caseload).

Climate-induced displacement has become increasingly prominent in Ethiopia. In 2015, Ethiopia faced one of the strongest onsets of El Niño, a periodic heating of the eastern tropical Pacific, which reduced the kiremt rainfall³, and successively resulted in drought in the Southern and Southeastern parts of the country⁴. Communities in southern and eastern Ethiopia, including the lowlands of Somali, Oromia and Afar regions, continue to be impacted by the prolonged drought resulting from the five consecutive failed rainy seasons since late 2020⁵. Drought has primarily been identified in Oromia and Somali regions, particularly the zones of Afder, Nogob and Liben, and some parts of Dawa, Shabelle and Siti in the Somali region, as well as the Borena, West Guji and East Borena zones in the Oromia region⁶. As a result, acute food insecurity levels are increasing throughout the affected regions⁷. As of May 2024, drought was the primary cause of displacement for an estimated 544,002 IDPs (16.5% of the national IDP caseload), with IDPs

reporting this reason for displacement concentrated in Somali, Oromia and Afar regions. Somali region hosts the highest number of IDPs primarily displaced by drought nationwide (an estimated 397,913 individuals or 73.1% of the national drought caseload).

The Government of Ethiopia issued a national flood alert in January 2024, following a forecast by the Ethiopian Meteorological Institute (EMI), anticipating river flood and flash floods during the March-May 2024 belg rainy season⁸. According to the Ethiopia Disaster Risk Management Commission (EDRMC), heavy rains in April and early May caused flooding in several regions across the country, particularly in Afar, Amhara, Central Ethiopia, Oromia, Sidama, Somali, South Ethiopia, and Tigray regions, as predicted by EMI. The rains, and the unusually heavy wind accompanying the rainy season this year, have led to significant damage to houses, public infrastructure, and croplands⁹. As of May 2024, an estimated 276,868 IDPs reported other climate induced reasons as the main cause of displacements, especially concentrated in Somali and Afar regions. Other climate induced reasons include flash floods, seasonal floods, landslides and fire. Somali region hosts the highest number of IDPs primarily displaced by other climate induced reasons nationwide (an estimated 199,590 IDPs or 72.1% of the national other climate induced reasons caseload). The weather conditions have limited the population's access to services and

deepened vulnerabilities, particularly in areas already affected by conflict and violence, prolonged drought, as well as pre-existing poor road infrastructure⁹. The confluence of these shocks with disease outbreaks, such as cholera, malaria, and measles, is further exacerbating the vulnerability of affected communities, including IDPs and returning IDPs¹⁰. While some IDPs have had opportunities to return, others continue to live in displacement, dependent on limited humanitarian assistance and lacking access to substantial recovery support or durable solutions¹¹.

Ethiopia additionally faces high mobility due to the large number of returnees in Amhara, Tigray and Afar regions, after the end of the Northern Ethiopia crisis following the signed cessation of hostilities in November 2022.

Tensions in Amhara region have been rising since April 2023, when the federal government announced it was dismantling regional forces across Ethiopia, triggering protests and insecurity¹². In August 2023, the Ethiopian government declared a six-month state of emergency in Amhara region and announced curfews in six cities¹³. Since then, conflict has remained ongoing, and the region remains partially inaccessible. Additionally following the influx from Sudan since April 2023, the humanitarian situation in West Gondar zone, Amhara region, has been exacerbated by limited humanitarian action due to access constraints and limited resources, adding to the overstretch of public services such as water and health¹⁴.

IOM Population Observation in Ethiopia

In order to capture population mobility and internal displacement in Ethiopia, IOM's Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) is deployed to track IDPs, returning IDPs, migrants and returned migrants. IOM entered into partnership with the Government of Ethiopia's Disaster Risk Management Commission (EDRMC) in August 2016, and has been regularly implementing DTM assessments in Ethiopia since September 2016.

DTM tools active in Ethiopia include a Site Assessment (SA) which focuses on tracking internal displacement and a Village Assessment Survey (VAS) aimed at tracking returns. SA covers locations where there are reports of 20 or more IDP households, whereas VAS covers locations where there are reportedly 20 or more returning IDP households that returned on or after

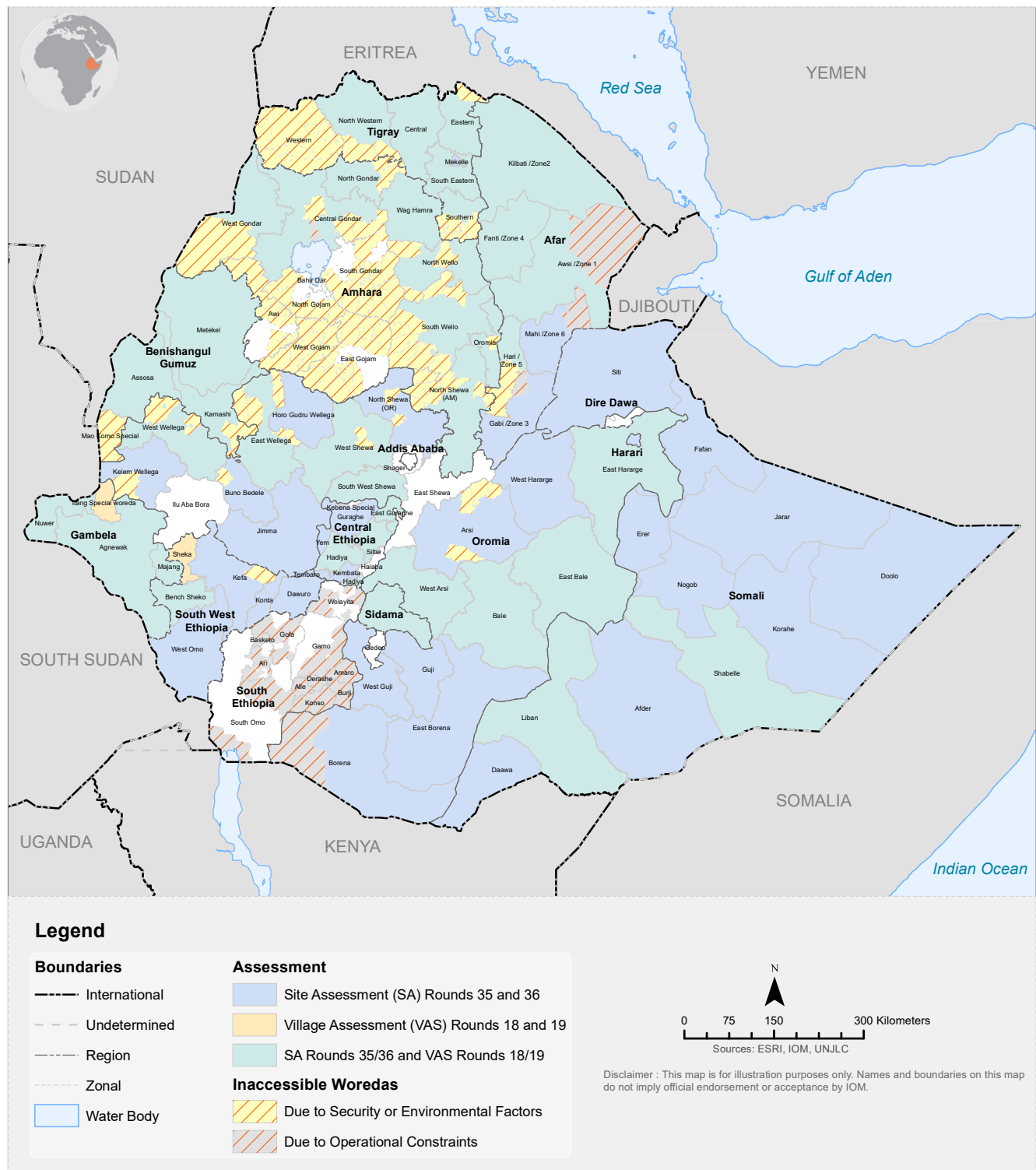


Figure 1 illustrates IOM-DTM's coverage of its Site Assessment (SA) Round 35 and 36 and Village Assessment Survey (VAS) Round 18 and 19 carried out between November 2023 - May 2024 in Ethiopia. The areas in blue represent areas that were exclusively covered by SA in rounds 35 and 36, while the areas in yellow represent areas that were only covered by VAS in rounds 18 and 19. The areas in green represent areas where both SA and VAS were deployed. The grey areas covered in red stripes represent areas that were inaccessible due to operational constraints, while the yellow with red stripes represents areas inaccessible due to security or environmental factors.

1 January 2022. Between April and May 2024, IOM DTM deployed the SA round 36 and VAS round 19, in 11 regions across Ethiopia, as seen in Figure 1 on the following page.

The November - December 2023 data (Round 35 for SA and Round 18 for VAS) was compiled with the April - May 2024 data (Round 36 for SA and Round 19 for VAS) to consolidate national IDP and returning IDP figures updated to May 2024. The locations assessed during both rounds of data collection are not duplicated in the consolidated figures. Figure 1 illustrates DTM's coverage through the consolidated SA and VAS tools. South Ethiopia region was not included for this round due to operational constraints.

TRACKING INTERNAL DISPLACEMENT

2.1 SITE ASSESSMENT METHODOLOGY



Data collection:

24 November 2023 – 01 May 2024

IOM Ethiopia employs a series of tools through its DTM. The present methodology refers to the Site Assessment (SA) tool which falls under the Mobility Tracking (MT) component of the DTM.

Since September 2016, IOM Ethiopia has conducted 36 rounds of data collection. The DTM programme is implemented in collaboration with the Ethiopia Disaster Risk Management Commission (EDRMC) and lower admin level counterparts. IOM's DTM team is composed of 172 field enumerators, under the direct supervision of 14 field focal points, and the overall supervision of the DTM team based in IOM's Addis Ababa Country Office. The data collection methodology is divided into three administrative levels:

Zone level: Data is collected through interviews with key informants from the Disaster Risk Management Office (DRMO), community representatives, and the education and health offices. This data includes the estimated number of displaced individuals, a list of woredas within the zone that host IDPs, reasons for displacement, time of arrival and their locations.

Woreda level: Information is collected through key informants at woreda level and includes the estimated number of displaced households and individuals at woreda and kebele level, site typology and approximate locations of identifiable displacement sites, among other indicators. The site location information is used to plan the roll out of data collection at the site level (SA).

Site level: SA is conducted in locations hosting a reported 20 or more IDP households defined through previous rounds of data collection and the above-mentioned interviews at the higher administrative levels. Sites with fewer than 20 IDP households are not assessed. Information is collected through group discussions with key informants (IDP representatives, including men, women, elderly, and youth), key informant interviews, household surveys, and direct observation. SA gathers information on IDPs, including on their locations, their areas of origin, reasons for displacement, and household demographics.

Demographic information was collected through representative sampling at the site level at a 95% confidence interval and a 10% margin of error. Overall, 136,918 households were interviewed nationwide to inform the demographic information, length of displacement and reasons for displacement.

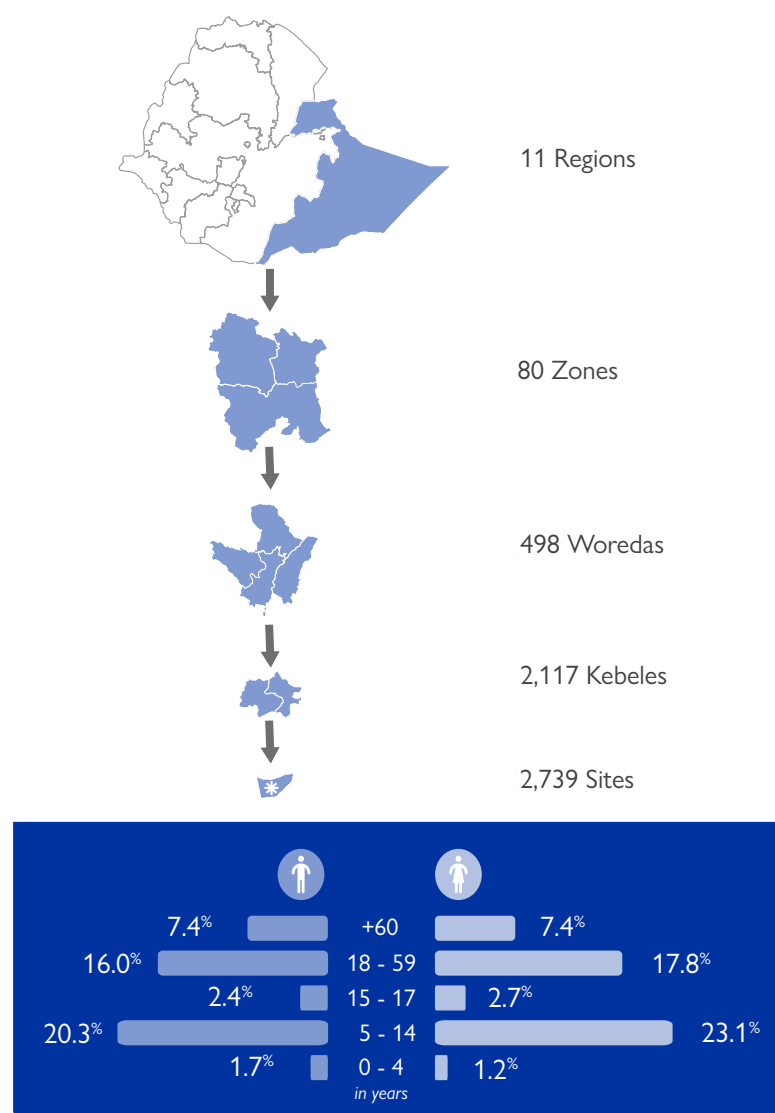
The SA round 35 (November - December 2023) data was compiled with the SA round 36 (April - May 2024) data to consolidate a national IDP figure updated to May 2024 for 2,739 sites. The sites assessed during both round 35 and round 36 are not duplicated in the consolidated figure. The detailed breakdown can be found in the below table.

It is to be noted that South Ethiopia region is not included due to operational constraints.

2.2 NATIONAL OVERVIEW

COVERAGE OF THE CONSOLIDATED SITE ASSESSEMENT (SA) ROUND 36



As of May 2024, an estimated 664,509 households comprising 3,306,693 IDPs were identified in 2,739 accessible sites across Ethiopia. Conflict was the primary reason for displacement reported nationally (68.7%), followed by drought (16.5%) and other climate induced reasons* (8.4%). Due to both insecurity and environmental factors, several sites were inaccessible which affected coverage this round. In addition, South Ethiopia region was not included for this round due to operational constraints.

Even though accessibility in Amhara has improved since round 34 (August - September 2023), data collection in Amhara region continues to be affected due to insecurity. In previous rounds the caseload from Amhara region represented almost 10% of the total national displacement caseload identified¹⁵. Therefore, the IDP regional (for Amhara) and national figures should likely be higher.

*Other climate induced reasons includes flash floods, seasonal floods, landslides and fire.

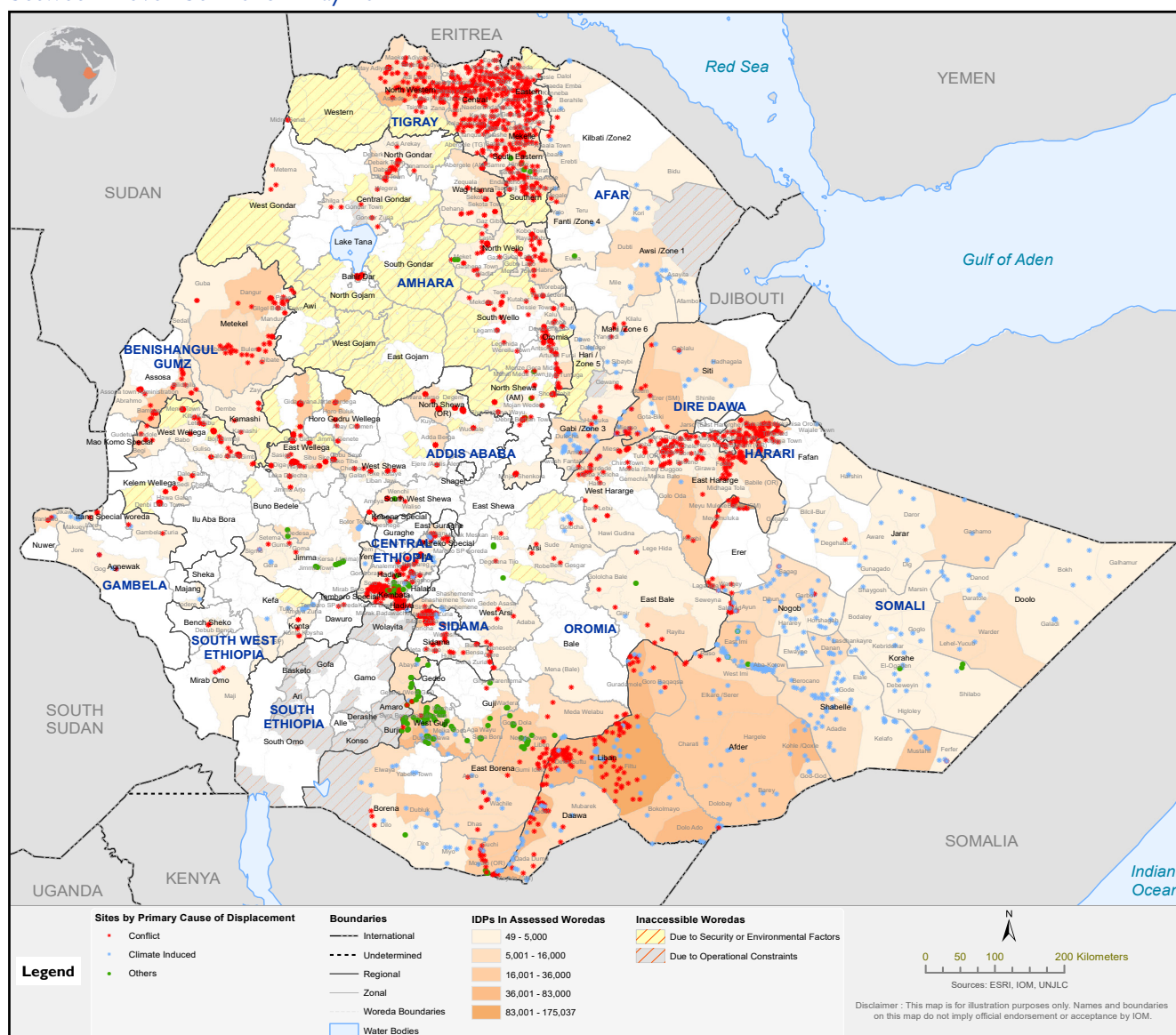

2.3 OVERVIEW OF DISPLACEMENT

NATIONAL LEVEL

Figure 2: The estimated IDP caseload in Ethiopia based on the consolidated data collection between November 2023 - May 2024



As of May 2024, an estimated 3,306,693 IDPs (664,509 households) were internally displaced across 2,739 assessed, accessible sites in Ethiopia. This reflects a 3.5% increase of an estimated 112,280 IDPs since the previous data collection round 35 (November - December 2023). It is to be noted that South Ethiopia region was not included for this round due to operational constraints. The gender breakdown of displaced individuals was fairly equal with 52.2% females and 47.8% males.

Conflict was the primary cause of displacement for an estimated 2,272,533 IDPs (68.7%), followed by drought which was the primary reason for displacement for an estimated 544,002 IDPs (16.5%) and other climate induced reasons (primary reason for displacement for an estimated 276,868 individuals or 8.4% of the national caseload).

Other climate induced reasons include displacement due to flash floods, seasonal floods, landslides and fire.

The regions of Somali (an estimated 1,093,745 IDPs or 33.1%), Oromia (an estimated 881,984 IDPs or 26.7%) and Tigray (an estimated 878,325 IDPs or 26.6%) account for the highest IDP caseloads nationwide.

Somali region also hosts the highest number of IDPs primarily displaced by drought nationwide (an estimated 397,913 individuals or 73.1% of the national drought caseload), while Tigray region hosts the highest number of IDPs primarily displaced by conflict nationwide (an estimated 871,056 individuals or 38.3% of the national conflict caseload).



VILLAGE ASSESSMENT SURVEY(VAS)

TRACKING RETURNS

3.1 VILLAGE ASSESSMENT METHODOLOGY



Data collection:
23 November 2023 - 30 April 2024

IOM Ethiopia employs a series of tools through its DTM. The present methodology refers to the Village Assessment Survey (VAS) tool which falls under the Mobility Tracking component of the DTM.

The Village Assessment Survey (VAS) was used for the first time in IOM Ethiopia in July 2019 in response to government-led return movements in an effort to capture return trends and sectoral needs in areas reporting high return concentrations. This is the 19th round of VAS data collection. VAS targets villages with reported returns equal to or greater than 20 returning IDP households that returned from 1 January 2022. The purpose of VAS is to assess the capacity of villages to absorb returns through the availability of services with a focus on reintegration. All VAS data is collected in collaboration with the Ethiopia Disaster Risk Management Commission (EDRMC) at the federal and lower administrative levels:

Zone level: Data is collected through interviews with key informants from the Disaster Risk Management Office (DRMO), community representatives, and the education and health offices. This data includes the estimated number of returning IDP individuals, a list of woredas within the zone that host returning IDPs, their reasons for initial displacement, time of return and locations.

Woreda level: Information is collected through key informants at the woreda level and includes the estimated number of returning IDP households and individuals at woreda and kebele levels, village typology and approximate locations of identifiable villages of return, among other indicators. The information on village locations is used to plan the roll out of the Village Assessment Survey (VAS).

Village level: The VAS is conducted in locations hosting a reported 20 or more returning IDP households that returned after 1 January 2022, defined through previous rounds of data collection and the above mentioned interviews at the higher administrative levels. Villages with fewer than 20 returning IDP households, or with solely returns before 1 January 2022 are not assessed. Information is collected through group discussions with key informants, key informant interviews, household surveys, and direct observation. VAS gathers information on returning IDPs, including on their locations, reasons for initial displacement and household demographics.

Demographic information was collected through representative sampling at the village level at a 95% confidence interval and a 10% margin of error. Overall, 140,620 households were interviewed nationwide to inform the demographic information, and reason for initial displacement prior to return.

The VAS Round 18 (November - December 2023) data

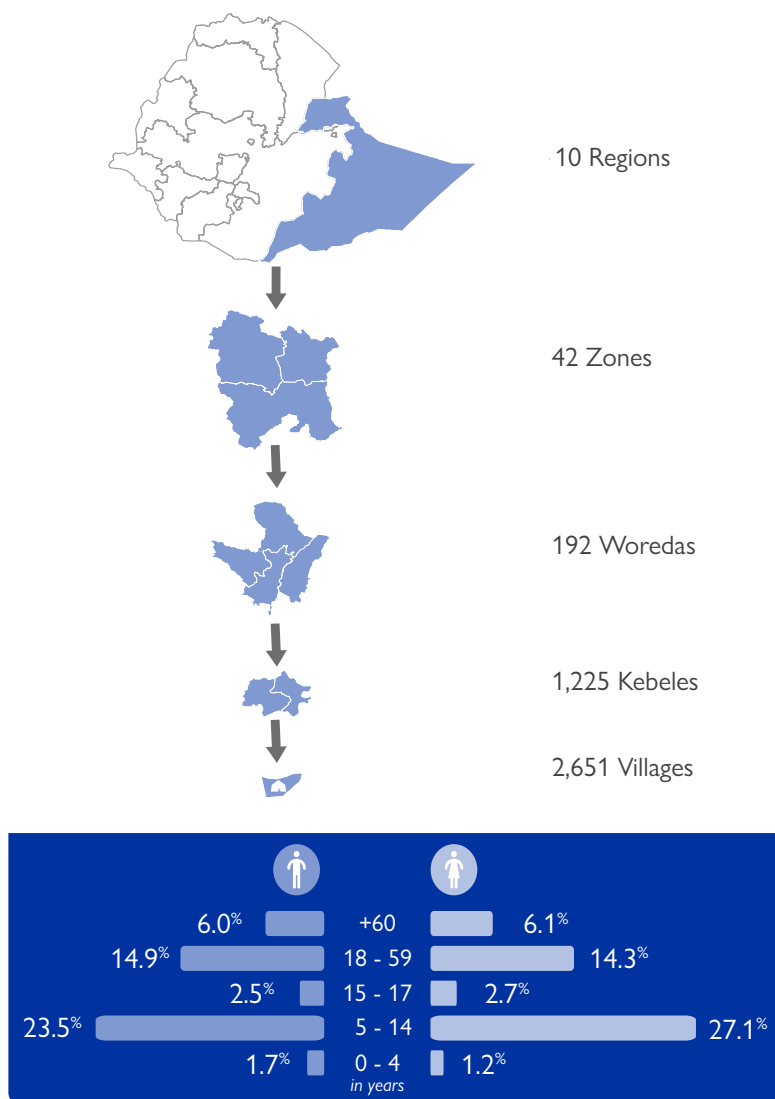
was compiled with the VAS Round 19 (April 2024) data to consolidate a national returning IDP figure updated to April 2024 for 2,651 villages. The villages assessed during both round 18 and round 19 are not duplicated in the consolidated figure. It is to be noted that South Ethiopia region is not included for this round due to operational constraints.

In round 18 of data collection (November - December 2023), the VAS methodology was been updated to only track returns that happened on or after 1 January 2022 with the methodological threshold of 20 returning IDP HHs or more. Previously, the VAS methodology tracked returns that happened on or after 1 January 2021 with the same methodological threshold.

As of April 2024, an estimated 593,543 returning IDP households comprising 2,584,607 returning IDPs were identified in 2,651 accessible villages across Ethiopia.

Conflict was the primary reason for initial displacement nationally (94.2%), followed by other climate induced reasons* (4.2%) and drought (1.6%). Due to both insecurity and environmental factors, several villages were inaccessible which affected coverage, indicating that the total national return caseload should likely be higher. In addition, South Ethiopia region was not included for this round due to operational constraints.

The figures from this round represent a decrease of an estimated 82,021 returning IDPs (-3.1%) since round 18 (November - December 2023).

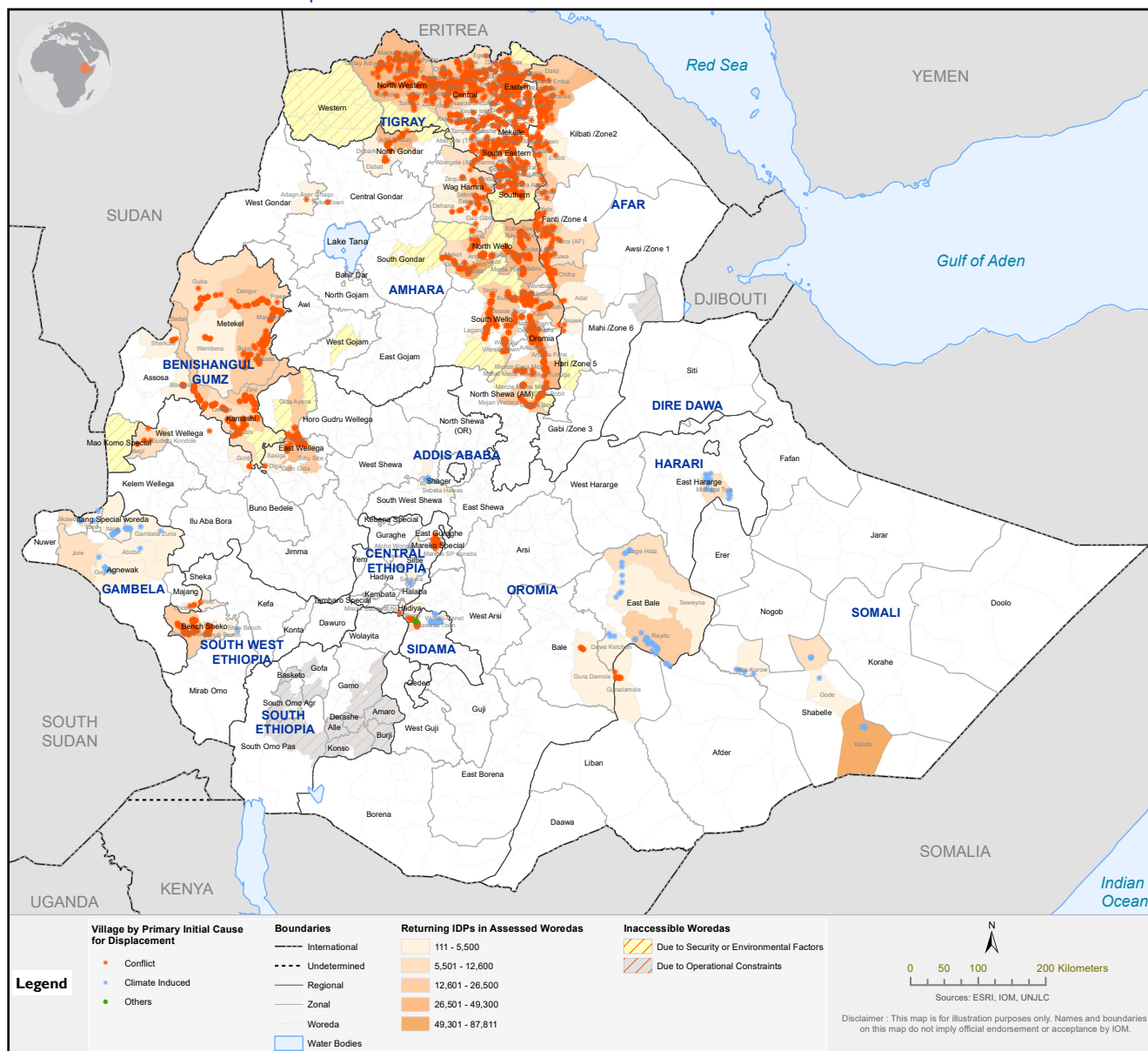

3.3 OVERVIEW OF RETURNS

NATIONAL LEVEL

Figure 3: The estimated returning IDP caseload in Ethiopia based on the consolidated data collection between November 2023 - April 2024



As of April 2024, IOM DTM identified an estimated 2,584,607 returning IDPs (593,543 returning IDP households) across 2,651 assessed, accessible villages in Ethiopia. The gender breakdown of returning individuals is fairly equal with 51.4% females and 48.6% males.

Conflict is the primary reported cause of initial displacement for the majority of returning IDPs in assessed villages, followed by other climate induced reasons* and drought. Tigray region hosts the highest number of reported returning IDPs (an estimated 970,265 returning IDPs or 37.5% of the national caseload). This is followed by Amhara region (an estimated 951,931

returning IDPs or 36.8% of the national caseload) and Afar region (an estimated 223,313 returning IDPs or 8.6% of the national caseload).

Tigray region also hosts the highest number of villages reporting returning IDPs initially displaced due to conflict nationwide (an estimated 968,641 returning IDPs or 39.8% of the national caseload initially displaced due to conflict), while Somali region hosts the highest number of returning IDPs initially displaced by other climate induced reasons* nationwide (an estimated 68,280 individuals or 63.1% of the national caseload initially displaced due to other climate induced reasons*).

*Other climate induced reasons include flash floods, seasonal floods, landslides and fire.
