

## Wau PoC sites & collective centres

Data collection January 2019

Wau Town features two PoC sites and five collective centres in which IOM-DTM conducts monthly headcounts to monitor changing population dynamics and displacement trends. These include: Wau PoC 1 and Wau PoC AA sites, as well as Cathedral, Nazareth, St. Joseph, Lokoloko and Masna collective centres.

Throughout 2018, a steady decline in the Wau PoC AA site population could be observed. Between January 2018 and January 2019, Wau PoC AA decreased by 40 per cent of its population- a reduction of 10,116 individuals. The population of Wau PoC AA decreased by 359 individuals since December 2018 and stands at 14,913 individuals in January 2019.

Population by Zone and block, Wau PoC AA (January 2019)




Wau PoC AA and collective sites by population size


Wau collective centres population figures in January 2019 documented a net increase of 70 individuals since December 2018. Per location, population figures and dynamics were:

- Cathedral 4,476 individuals **↑ 216 increase** from Dec'18
- Masna 3,323 individuals **↑ 31 increase** from Dec'18
- Lokoloko 1,910 individuals **↓ 28 decrease** from Dec'18
- Nazareth 699 individuals **↓ 121 decrease** from Dec'18
- St. Joseph 247 individuals **↓ 28 decrease** from Dec'18
