


Figures represent DTM findings from Mobility Tracking Round 4 (data collected Nov to Dec 2018). Please note that these are not representative for the entire country as not all locations have been assessed.

Internally displaced people (IDPs) refers to persons who have been forced or obliged to flee, or to leave their homes or places of habitual residence, in particular as a result of or in order to avoid the effects of armed conflict, situations of generalized violence, violations of human rights or natural or human-made disasters, and who have not crossed an internationally recognized state border. IOM considers IDPs displaced since December 2013.
