




Wau PoC sites & collective centres

Data collection February 2019

Wau Town features two PoC sites and five collective centres in which IOM-DTM conducts monthly headcounts to monitor changing population dynamics and displacement trends. In February 2019, the monthly count was held in Wau PoC AA site, as well as Cathedral, Nazareth, St. Joseph, Lokoloko and Masna collective centres. Throughout 2018 until February 2019, a steady decline in the Wau PoC AA site population was observed. Between January 2019 and February 2019, the **Wau PoC AA population decreased by seven per cent** - a reduction of 1,787 individuals.




Wau collective centres population figures in January 2019 documented a net decrease of 504 individuals comparing with January 2019. Per location, population figures and dynamics were:

- Cathedral 4,680 individuals ↑ 204 increase from Jan'19
- Masna 3,831 individuals ↑ 508 increase from Jan'19
- Lokoloko 938 individuals ↓ 972 decrease from Jan'19
- Nazareth 506 individuals ↓ 193 decrease from Jan'19
- St. Joseph 196 individuals ↓ 51 decrease from Jan'19
