## IDP LOCATIONS & POPULATION

### IRAQ IDP CRISIS - JANUARY 2014 TO 26 MAY 2016

IOM's DTM aims to monitor displacement and provide accurate data about the IDP population in Iraq. Data is collected by Rapid Assessment and Response Teams (RART), composed of 140 staff on the entire Iraqi territory. Data is gathered via a network of over 1,300 key informants.

From the start of January 2014 through 26 May 2016, the DTM has identified 3,306,822 internally displaced individuals (551,137 families). This map shows locations where IDPs are currently residing, as well as overall concentrations across the country.



