





Anbar governorate hosts the largest IDP population (17% or 538,854 individuals) and reports a very high rate of intragovernorate displacement, with 98% of IDPs originally from the same governorate. IDPs were displaced mainly after April 2015 (37%) and before June 2014 (35%). The majority is housed in private settings (59%), out which 51% in host families and 9% in rented houses, while a smaller portion (19%) is in critical shelters. Finally, Anbar governorate hosts 28% of the total returnees (279,804 individuals).

Anbar

Baghdad governorate hosts the second largest IDP population (14% or 452208 individuals). The majority of this population is originally from Anbar governorate (69%), while a smaller portion (6%) are originally from Baghdad governorate. IDPs were displaced mainly after April 2015 (37%) and between September 2014 and March 2015 (26%). The vast majority (91%) is hosted in private settings. In addition, Baghdad hosts 3% of the total returnee population (31,284 individuals).
