Following an armed attack on 03 June 2019 on the village of Grayrom located on an island of Lake Chad (in the department of Mamdi, sous-préfecture of Bol) 1,007 households of 7,015 individuals from villages of Marteh 1, Marteh 2, Marteh 3, Dinakam, Grayrom I, Grayrom 2, Grayrom 3, Biyam, Katouga I, Katouga 2, Djoloua and Foulou located in the same souspréfecture arrived on 08 June 2019 to the site of Koulkimé 2 located in the department of Kaya (sous-préfecture of Baga Sola).


