

Overview

As of the 15th January 2017, the total number of internally displaced persons (IDPs) in the UN Mission in South Sudan's Protection of Civilians (PoC) site in Bentiu was 120,079 individuals. The first round January 2017 population count was held in Bentiu PoC from the 13 to 15 January 2017. Compared to the previous count conducted in end of December, the population increased from 119,853 individuals to 120,079 individuals.






Population Heat Map for Bentiu PoC




Population per Sector




SqM per Person




Population <5 and ≥5 years




Population living in communal shelters and tents
