

### Context

Wau POC area adjacent to UNMISS was established in June 2016, following violence in and around Wau town, making it the most recently established POC in South Sudan. It is also the most congested POC in the country, with more than 29,021 IDPs sheltering on just 134,514 m<sup>2</sup> of land.






#### Methodology - return intention survey


Quantitative data was collected during the survey to determine the pre-displacement area of residence for IDPs in the PoC. A sample of 383 households or 7.5% of the estimated number of households (at the time 5,112) was considered at a random interval of shelters, and at random intervals of persons exiting the PoC gate. Data is as of October 2016.

### Movement Trend Tracking (MTT) for the period


