### SUMMARY OF EVENT

Following a suicide attack that took place on 14 August in the village of Kaiga-Kindjiria, in the sous-préfecture of Kaiga-Kindjiria (Département of Fouli), 124 households of 570 individuals fled to the Kilikara and Ngorea I sites, all located in the same sous-préfecture. Among them, 100 households of 500 individuals fled to the site of Kilikara and 24 households of 70 individuals to the site of Ngorea I.
