Following a conflict between farmers and pastoralist herders on 26 August in the village of Sandana, in the département of Barh-Kôh, sous-préfecture of Koumogo, 1,000 individuals fled to the villages of Koumogo (département of Barh-Kôh, subous-préfecture of Koumogo) and Danamadji (département of Grande Sido, sous-préfecture of Danamadji).


