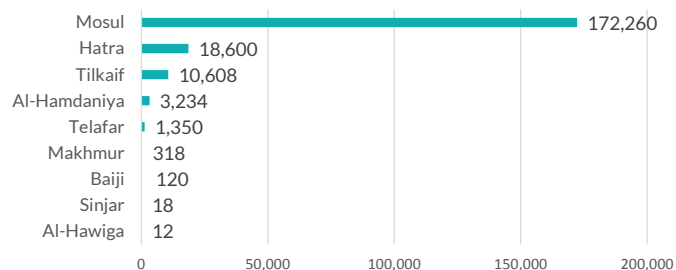

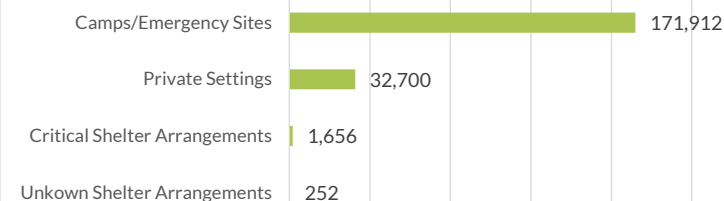

Number of individuals displaced, by district of origin

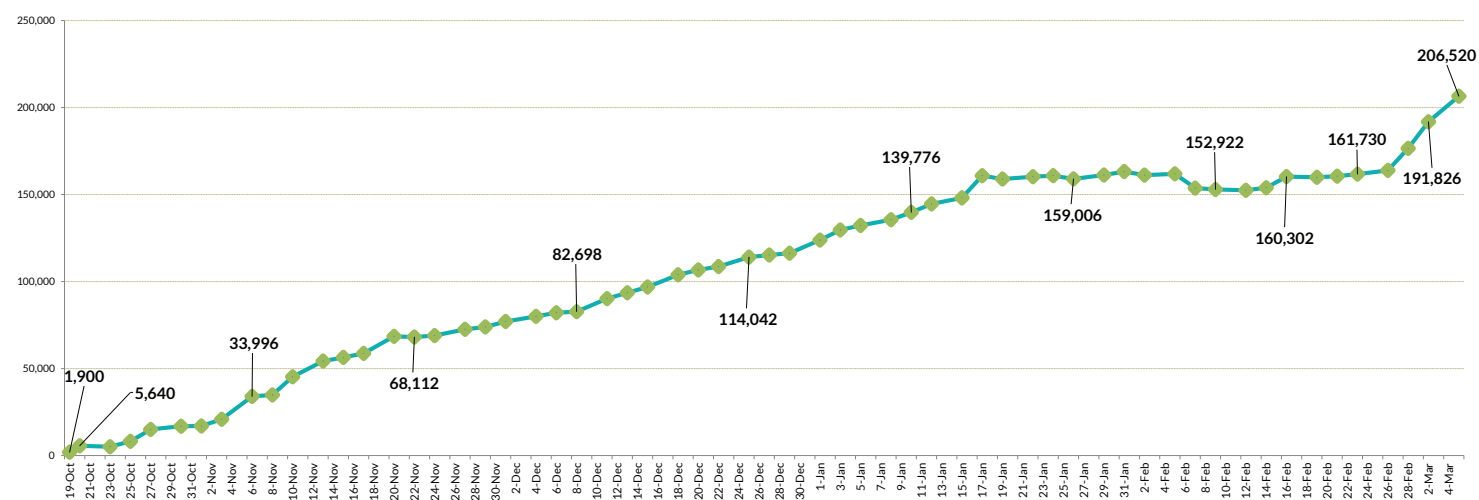


WHERE ARE PEOPLE STAYING?

NUMBER OF DISPLACED INDIVIDUALS IDENTIFIED BY EMERGENCY TRACKING SINCE 17 OCTOBER



As of 4 March:

- From 2 to 4 March, Khazer M1 camp and Hassansham M2 (former Khazer M2) camp reported the arrival of approximately 999 families from Markaz al Mosul;
- Haj Ali camp in Qayyarah sub-district reported an overall increase of approximately 95 IDP families;
- Qayyarah Jad'ah 2 reported the decrease of 2 IDP families, while Qayyarah Jad'ah 3 reported an increase of approximately 17 IDP families;
- Approximately 37 families arrived to Qayyarah Jad'ah 4 camp, while 42 left;
- Qayyarah Airstrip emergency site currently registered population is 4,698 IDP families;
- Hammam Al Aliei camp currently registered population is 3,443 IDP families;
- Ongoing field visits allowed to identify approximately 150 IDP families in Al-Shibali village.

*Emergency tracking numbers are not cumulative. They reflect a snapshot of displacement on the day of reporting. The number of individuals is calculated by multiplying the number of identified families by six, which is the average size of an Iraqi family.

The IOM Iraq Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) is the standard data source being used in Iraq to guide the humanitarian response. Emergency tracking for the Mosul operations began identifying people displaced resulting from military actions that began on 17 October.
