### TOTAL NUMBER OF IDPS CURRENTLY DISPLACED








## WHERE ARE PEOPLE STAYING?

## As of March 27:

- Haj Ali camp reported an overall increase of approximately 310 IDP families:
- Qayyarah airstrip emergency site reported an overall decrease of approximately 19 IDP families;
- Official figures are not available yet but according to field visits Hasansham M2 camp recorded an increase of 65 IDP families;
- Official figures about the IDP population in Nargizliya 1 and 2 camps are now available.
