DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects and reports on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs. In the first nine months of 2019, conflict has resulted in new patterns of displacement, particularly in within Hajjah, Al Hudaydah, Al Dhale'e, Taizz governorates.

Between 10 and 16 November, newly displaced households were recorded in Taizz (284 HH), Al Dhale'e (115 HH) and Al Hudaydah (77). Most of these displacements were the result of increased fighting in Taizz (264 HH) Al Dhale'e (145 HH) and Al Hudaydah (102 HH).

REPEAT DISPLACEMENT

60 IDP households left their location of displacement and moved either to their place of origin or to some other displaced location.


