

5,235 individuals are reported to have returned to Al Zaafran, Al Gharbyat and Al Sabaa

> Over the last 3 weeks, 4,450 individuals are reported to have returned to their home in Alsabaemia

5,750 individuals are reported to have returned to District 3

> 4,500 individuals are reported as returned to Al Swawa and Abu Zahia over the past 6 months

> During the last week 2,755 individuals are reported as having returned to Aljiza

2,755 individuals are reported to have returned to Sirte during the course of the last week. Out of the families that are reported to have returned 100 families are reported to be coming from Zliten, 200 from Bani Walid, 180 from Aljufra and 300 from Sabha. The main reason as to why people are reported as returning to Sirte is to verify the conditions of their proprieties and the general conditions of Sirte.

The Incident Tracker is part of IOM Libya's Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) programme. DTM is a suite of tools that provide a comprehensive articulation of Libya's human mobility patterns. The Incident Tracker is a weekly tool collecting and triangulating information on the whole of Libya on any incidents related to IDPs, returnees and migrants, especially in regards to large population movements updates on border closures and new routes.
