

TECHNICAL NOTE

General Objective: Provide timely information on key population figures and main needs of affected Settlements in the Great/Little Abaco Islands to support humanitarian action and Government planning.

Geographic coverage: 23 affected Settlements in the Great/Little Abaco Islands. Outer Cays assessment is on-going.

Type: Key informant-based multi-sectoral location assessment (MSLA).

Instrument: Adapted Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM) MSLA questionnaire.

Number of responses: 66 (at least 2 per location).

Unit of Analysis: The Settlement.

Primary information source: Key informants on a community level (Local Government/Council functionaries, religious leaders, community representatives, etc.).

Secondary information sources: Government of the Bahamas (indicated below each table), Humanitarian partners' datasets and reports, IOM (Debris).

Reference period: 30 October - 5 November 2019.
