

DISPLACEMENT TRACKING

DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects and reports on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs. In the first nine months of 2019, conflict has resulted in new patterns of displacement, particularly in within Hajjah, Al Hudaydah, Al Dhale'e, Taizz governorates.

WEEKLY UPDATE

Between 17 and 23 November, newly displaced households were recorded in Al Dhale'e (293 HH), Marib (167 HH) and Taizz (124 HH). Most of these displacements were the result of increased fighting in Al Dhale'e (332 HH), Taizz (96 HH) and Al Hudaydah (74 HH).

REPEAT DISPLACEMENT

69 IDP households left their location of displacement and moved either to their place of origin or to some other displaced location.




