The Department of Education mandates that schools can only be used as evacuation centers for a maximum of 15 days. Medium- to long-term site infrastructure is not advisable for these types of sites at the moment.

Relocation options need to be found for IDPs in these types of sites. The site's camp management, while established and organized, still needs training especially on camp layout.
