REASONS PREVENTING RETURN OF IDPs

House damaged/destroyed, lack of safety, no livelihood

The Department of Education mandates that schools can only be used as evacuation centers for a maximum of 15 days. Medium- to long-term site infrastructure is not advisable for these types of sites at the moment. Relocation options need to be found for IDPs in these types of sites. The site needs assistance on camp management, livelihood and non-food items such as mosquito nets and hygiene kits.
