REASONS PREVENTING RETURN OF IDPs

House damaged/destroyed, no livelihood

The Department of Education mandates that schools can only be used as evacuation centers for a maximum of 15 days. Medium- to long-term site infrastructure is not advisable for these types of sites at the moment. Relocation options need to be found for IDPs in these types of sites. The site is organized but needs technical assistance on camp management, as well as additional nonfood items. They also need psychosocial support and stress debriefing activities such as family recreation and sports.
