DISPLACEMENT TRACKING

DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects and reports on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs. In the first nine months of 2019, conflict has resulted in new patterns of displacement, particularly in within Hajjah, Al Hudaydah, Al Dhale'e, Taizz governorates.

WEEKLY UPDATE

Between 08 and 14 December, newly displaced households were recorded in Hajjah (139 HH), Taizz (125 HH), Al Hudaydah (85 HH) and Al Dhale'e (66 HH). Most of these displacements were the result of increased fighting in Hajjah (171 HH), Al Hudaydah (129 HH), Al Dhale'e (71 HH) and Taiz (71 HH).

IDP HH WHO LEFT DISPLACED LOCATIONS

63 IDP households left their location of displacement and moved either to their place of origin or to some other displaced location.


