

The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to collect information on large and sudden population movements. Information is collected through key informant interviews or direct observation. This dashboard provides information on movements which occurred from **11 to 13 January 2020** in **5 villages** in the Lac Province..

SUMMARY OF EVENT

 **DISPLACED POPULATION : 3,463** Internally Displaced Persons, 754 households (estimates)

Following **attacks by armed groups** on 11 January 2020 in the village of **Ngorea I**, located in the sous-préfecture of **Kaiga-kindjiria** (Département of Foulï) and in the village of **Kallom** located in the sous-préfecture of **Ngouboua** (Département of Kaya), around **754 households of 3,463 individuals** fled to different villages located in the sous-préfectures of **Kaiga-kindjiria, Ngouboua, Liwa and Daboua**. The information received indicates that movements will likely continue in the coming days.
