



EMERGENCY EVENT TRACKING: El Geneina, West Darfur

UPDATE 5: 9 February 2020

Data collection: 6 February 2020



The DTM Emergency Event Tracking (EET) is deployed to track sudden displacement and population movements, provide more frequent updates on the scale of displacement and quantify the affected population when needed. As a subcomponent of the new Mobility Tracking methodology in Sudan (Round Zero), and activated on a need basis, EET utilises a broad network of key informants to capture best estimates of the affected population presence per location – a useful tool for humanitarian response planning and design.

Event Overview



DTM teams activated EET to monitor the displacement of individuals affected by the inter-communal violence in West Darfur – for more information see <u>EET EI Geneina 1</u>, <u>EET EI Geneina 2</u>, <u>EET EI Geneina 2</u>, <u>EET EI Geneina 3</u> and <u>EET EI Geneina 4</u>.

The fifth EET update estimates a total number of 40,017 individuals (8,307 households) situated across 37 sites of displacement in El Geneina, having arrived from 11 locations of origin. These figures indicate a decrease of 1,655 internally displaced persons (IDPs) (74 households) from the 41,672 IDPs (8,381 households) reported in the fourth EET update on 26 January 2020. Reports from the field suggest that IDPs with unaffected houses are now returning to their locations of origin. Displacement figures collected through this activity are further refined with each data collection round to reduce any discrepancies that may result from the miscorrelation of the EET methodology and that of DTM registration activities linked to direct humanitarian assistance.
