

The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to collect information on large and sudden population movements. Information is collected through key informant interviews or direct observation. This dashboard provides information on movements which occurred from 8 to 18 February 2020 in 4 sites in the Lac Province.


Between 8 and 18 February 2020, 1,215 individuals were displaced as a result of growing insecurity to multiple armed attacks in the Lac Province. Displaced households found refuge in four locations of Liwa sous-préfecture. Three of the displacement (on 8, 15-16 and 18 February) were preventive, while one displacement (on 13 February) was result of armed attack.

Sous-préfectures of origin


