


IDPs by location of displacement

Kirkuk governorate hosts the fourth largest displaced population (11% or 380,034 individuals). IDPs in Kirkuk are mainly from Anbar (32%), Salah al-Din (25%), and from within Kirkuk governorate (30%). They were displaced mainly in June-July 2014 (24%) and September 2014-March 2015 (23%). The majority of IDPs (63%) are in rented houses. Lower shares are in critical shelters (10%) and camps (6%). Furthermore, Sulayman Kirkuk hosts less than 1% of the total returnee population (2,388 individuals).

Anbar governorate hosts the largest IDP population (19% or 627,078 individuals) and reports a very high rate of intragovernorate displacement, with 98% of IDPs originally from the same governorate. IDPs were displaced mainly after April 2015 (38%) and before June 2014 (34%). The majority is housed in private settings (62%), out which 55% in host families and 8% in rented houses, while a smaller portion (18%) is in critical shelters. Finally, Anbar governorate hosts 24% of the total returnees (201,078 individuals).

Anbar

Baghdad governorate hosts the second largest IDP population (14% or 476,988 individuals). The majority of this population is originally from Anbar governorate (70%), while a smaller portion (6%) are originally from Baghdad governorate. IDPs were displaced mainly after April 2015 (38%) and between September 2014 and March 2015 (26%). The vast majority (90%) is hosted in private settings. In addition, Baghdad hosts 4% of the total returnee population (30,996 individuals).
