# IDPs and Returnees by sub-area (payam) Summaries, maps and datasets

IOM's Displacement Tracking is pleased to share with you several maps and a dataset detailing data on the numbers and locations of IDPs and returnees in all counties for 444 sub-areas (payam) disaggregated by period of displacement / return (data collection in March 2019). The data indicates an increased return trend since the signing of the Revitalized Agreement on the Resolution of the conflict in South Sudan in September 2018 (R-ARCSS) or Peace Agreement henceforth).

DTM mapped the presence of 1,420,189 persons internally displaced since 2014 and 1,183,683 individuals returned since 2016.

For the period since the R-ARCSS, 534,082 individuals have returned to their habitual residence of whom 210,199 (39%) came from abroad.

Of all individuals returned since 2016, 46 per cent arrived since the peace agreement. In other words, the seven-month period post R-ARCSS accounted for 45 per cent of all returnees compared to the 39-month period pre R-ARCSS, which accounted for 48 per cent of returnees (the rest unknown). The approximate average number of returnees per month stands at 17,900 individuals pre R-ARCSS and 76,000 individuals post R-ARCSS.

#### Returnees

Returnee: Someone who was displaced from their habitual residence either within South Sudan (former IDP) or abroad (former refugee), who has since returned to their habitual residence. Please note that the returnee category, for the purpose of DTM data collection, is restricted to individuals who returned to the exact location of their habitual residence or an adjacent area based on a free decision. South Sudanese displaced persons having crossed the border into South Sudan from neighbouring countries without having reached their home are still displaced and as such not considered returnees.
