IOM Yemen DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects data on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis from their locations of origin or displacement, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, geography and needs. It also tracks Returnees who returned to their location of origin.


During the reporting period, between 30 May and 05 June 2021, IOM Yemen DTM tracked 108 households (648 individuals) displaced at least once. From 01 January to 05 June 2021, IOM Yemen DTM estimates that 5,905 households (HH) (35,430 Individuals) have experienced displacement at least once.

Some 19 HH were displaced in the previous reporting period, which covered 23 - 29 May 2021. However, they were only identified in the current period and so, this figure has been added to the cumulative displacement total recorded from the beginning of the year.


