






IOM Yemen DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects data on numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis from their locations of origin or displacement, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements in terms of numbers, causes of displacement, geography and needs. It also tracks returnees who returned to their location of origin.

During the reporting period, between 05 and 11 December 2021, IOM Yemen DTM tracked 961 households (5,766 individuals) displaced at least once. Conflict was the main reason for displacement, accounting for 99 per cent (952 HH) of the total, followed by economic reasons, accounting for one per cent (9 HH).


From 01 January 2021 to 11 December 2021, IOM Yemen DTM estimates that 22,925 households (HH) (137,550 Individuals) have experienced displacement at least once.

Some 162 HH displaced in the previous reporting period (28 November - 04 December 2021) in governorates of Marib (76 HH), Al Maharah, Taiz (53 HH), Al Hodeidah (18HH), Aden (8 HH), and Al Maharah (7 HH) were only identified in the current reporting period. This figure has been added to the cumulative displacement total recorded from the beginning of the year.
