## IOM YEMEN DTM RAPID DISPLACEMENT TRACKING

YEMEN IDP DASHBOARD | REPORTING PERIOD: 9 TO 15 OCTOBER 2022



IOM Yemen DTM's Rapid Displacement Tracking (RDT) tool collects data on estimated numbers of households forced to flee on a daily basis from their locations of habitual residence or displacement, allowing for regular reporting of new displacements<sup>1</sup> in terms of estimated numbers, causes of displacement, geography and needs. It also tracks returnees who returned to their location of habitual residence.

Between 9 and 15 October 2022, IOM Yemen DTM tracked 55 households (330 individuals)<sup>2</sup> who experienced displacement at least once.

Economic reasons related to the conflict were the main reason for displacement, accounting for 56 per cent (31 HHs) of the total, followed by safety and security concerns as a result of the conflict, accounting for 44 per cent (24 HHs).

From 1 January to 15 October 2022, IOM Yemen DTM tracked 9,124 households (HH)<sup>3</sup> (54,744 Individuals) who experienced displacement at least once.

Since the beginning of the year, the number of tracked new instances of displacement has been declining in an irregular pattern.

 Displacement in Yemen refers to the 13 governorates where IOM DTM's team has access, namely: Abyan, Ad Dali', Aden, Al Bayda, Al Hodeidah, Al Jawf, Al Maharah, Hadramawt, Lahj, Ma'rib, Shabwah, Socotra, Ta'iz. 2. IOM DTM estimates that one household represents six individuals.

3. Please note that further additions to previous reporting periods can be reflected in cumulative totals without being individually addressed in narrative reports.


