

STRANDED MIGRANTS - DJIBOUTI

14/05/2020



Following the border closure in Ethiopia and due to the stricter border management policies in Yemen, some of the migrants who were transiting through Djibouti on their way to the Arabian Peninsula found themselves stranded in the country. These migrants live in spontaneous sites located along the migration route.

The Displacement Tracking Matrix (DTM), through its field enumerator teams and key informants, collects data on a daily basis at migrant sites across the country.

All reported migrants are Ethiopian nationals.


NOTE: This data does not include Djibouti City. The estimation of the distribution of migrants by sex is based on the March 2020 DTM flow monitoring dashboard.
