The DTM has been rolled out in over 30 countries including Haiti, Pakistan, Mali, The Democratic Republic of Congo and the Philippines. DTM was first rolled out in the Philippines in 2009 to support response efforts following Typhoon Ketsana.













Health: No referral system posted onsite.







Camp Management: Lack of trained camp managers in 2 ECs. No IDP committees organized. No ECMT visibility. No welfare desks.

EC Dwelling/Facilities: Lack of privacy partitions in dwelling spaces. No safe cooking counters. Need additional cooking counters.

Food and NFI: No supplemental feeding for children and for lactating/pregnant women. No manutrition screening conducted. Need other hygiene, (diapers, sleepers, clothing) family, and cleaning (walis, timba, tabo) kits.

WASH: No adequate drinking water in 2 ECs and no safe drinking water. Insufficient water taps, latrines and bathing cubicles. Need water containers.

Health: No referral system posted onsite, and no MHPPS conducted to the IDPs in 2 ECs. No health providers on

Education: No temporary learning spaces and informal education activities conducted in 3 ECs surveyed. All of the students are not able to continue their studies.

Protection: No VAW-CP awareness sessions conducted, in 3 of the sites. No protection referral pathway information posted in the 3 sites surveyed. No monitoring and reporting of GBV and child protection. No protective SVCS/Facilities in 3 ECs surveyed.

<u>Livelihood:</u> No sources of livelihood. Cash for work, need food assistance.
