




During Round 5, data was collected on the most important need for IDPs in each type of settlement and locations.

Needs were specified for 64% of identified IDPs with country-wide aggregated results indicating that NFIs, shelter and medical services are the three primary needs, combined accounting for 64.2% of IDPs in Libya.

**NOTE:** This map demonstrates the primary need of Libya's IDP population by province. The percentage of each primary need is based on 69,435 HH identified as IDPs during DTM Round 5.
