**Guma:** IDP population Increase due to influx from Mbabai, Uvir and Mbadwem wards as a result of banditary attacks.

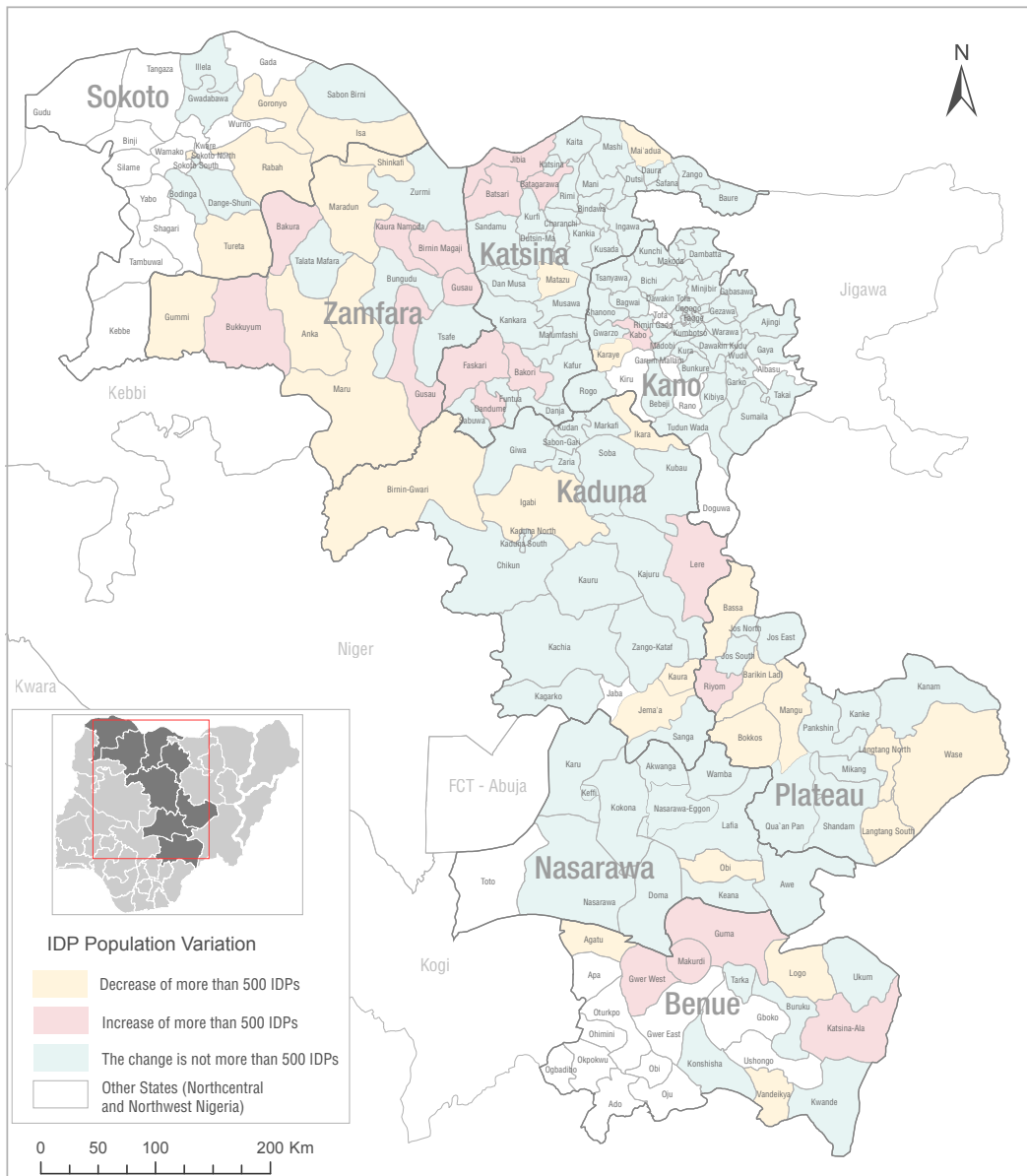
**Batsari:** IDP population Increase due to influx from differnt ward in the same LGA as a result of banditary attacks.

**Reasons for Decrease**

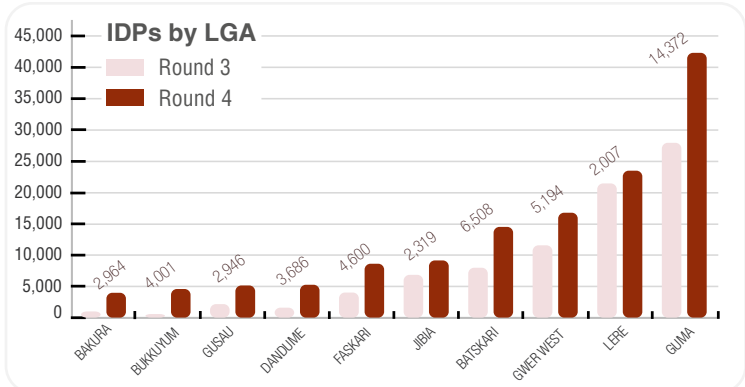
**Barikin Ladi:** IDP population decrease due to the close down of two sites (Ban and Kworos) in the LGA as they all reutered to their place of origin.

**Goronyo:** IDP population decrease due to the IDPs returning to their place of origin as a result of improved security.

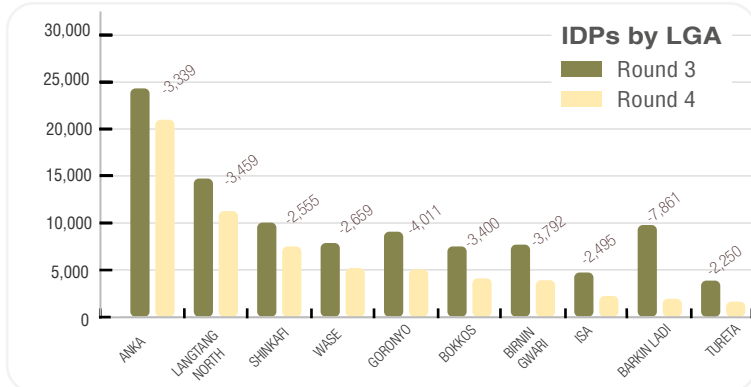
- Karaye LGA of Kano State was inaccessible during Round 4 assessments because of flooding.
