



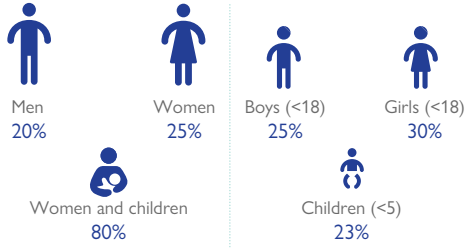

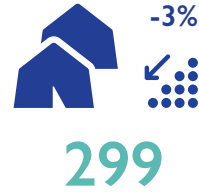
Demographic composition in camps/camp-like settings:



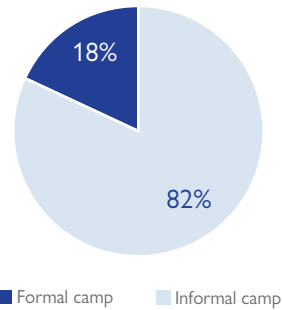
In camps/camp-like settings:

- 45% of IDPs have been previously displaced.
- 67% of IDPs cited tarpaulin as the most needed shelter material.
- 2% of IDPs did not have access to potable water.
- 44% of IDPs cited blankets/mats as the most needed NFI.
- 65% of education facilities are located outside of the camp/camp-like setting.
- 56% of IDPs cited malaria as the most common health problem.
- 14% of IDPs do not have access to regular medication.
- 23% of IDPs do not have access to food support. In 86% of the sites surveyed, IDPs cited food as the main unmet need.

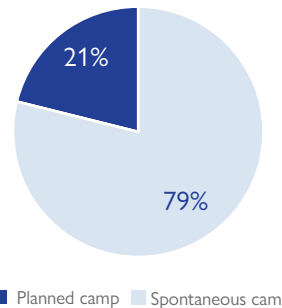

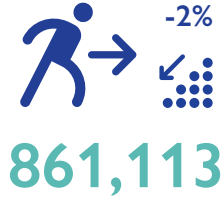
Sites number by status



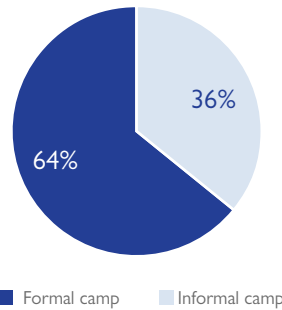
Sites by classification



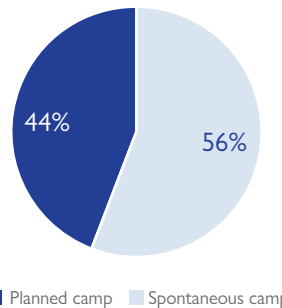
IDP in camps/camp-like settings



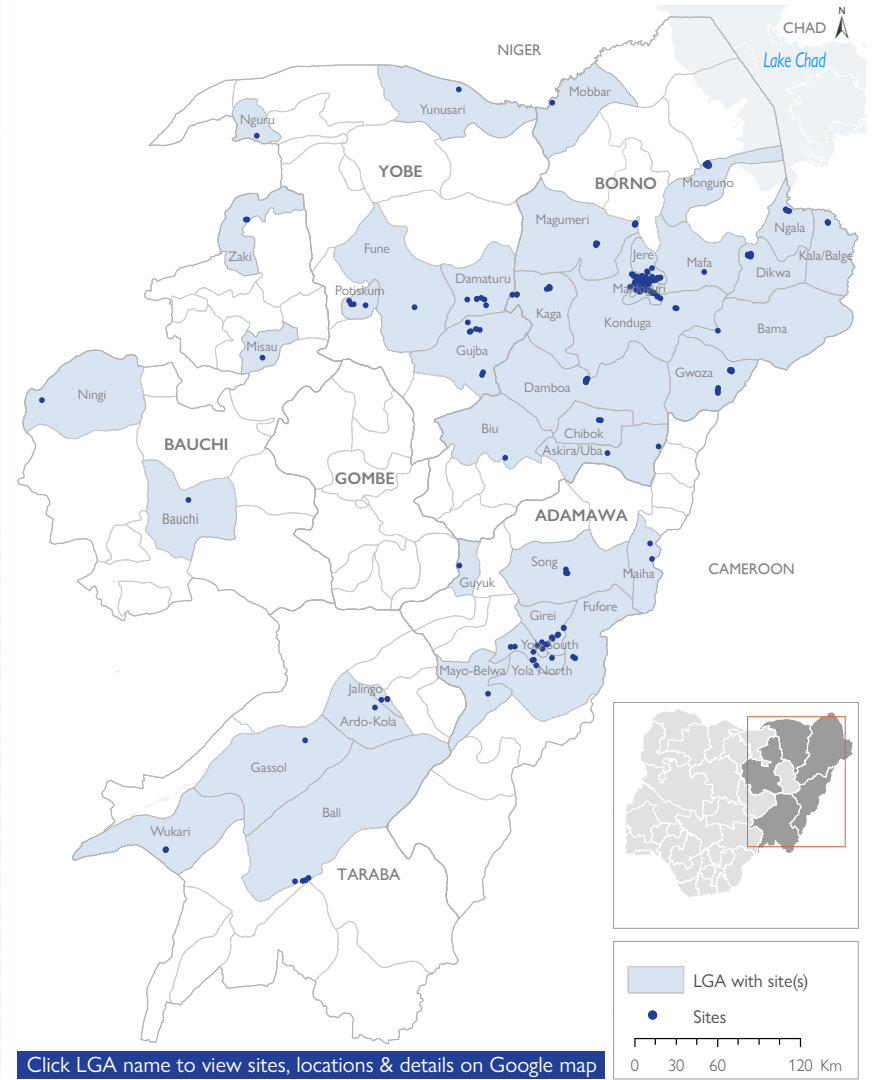
Population by site status
