112 migrants were reportedly found in a truck on the week of 15 June. The migrants were reported to have been held by smugglers. They were transferred to detention centres in the area.


MISRATAH

A peace agreement was signed on 19 June between the mayor of Misrata and the Tawergha Local Council. The agreement would enable Tawergha IDPs, the majority of whom were displaced in 2011, to return.

On 21 June 6 migrants (2 from Cameroon and 4 from Nigeria) were reported to have been kidnapped and assaulted on the road between Sebha and Ashshwayrif.

One of the migrants was reported to have died as a result. The remaining migrants were found in poor health condition in Bani Waleed.
