The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to collect information on large and sudden population movements. Information is collected through key informant interviews or direct observation. This dashboard provides information on displacement which occurred on 18 and 19 July 2021 in one village and one site of Lac Province.


SUMMARY OF EVENT



DISPLACED POPULATION:

206 Displaced individuals, 50 Households (estimates)

Following an armed attack by non-state armed groups on 16 July 2021 in the site of Kilikara, 50 households (206 individuals) left the site of Kilikara located in the islands of Lake Chad in the sous-préfecture of Kaiga-kindjiria, département of Fouli) to take refuge in the village of Kaiga-kindjiria centre, located on the mainland (in the same sous-préfecture) and in the site of Diamerom (sous-préfecture of Liwa, département of Fouli). Among these displaced people, 20 households are made up of returnees from Niger who fled this country in 2016 to settle in Kilikara, and 30 households made up of Internally Displaced Persons who left their place of residence in the village of Adilia (sous-préfecture of Kaiga-Kindjiria) and settled in Kilikara in 2016.


