
Assessment conducted in affected areas

The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to collect information on large and sudden population movements. Information is collected through key informant interviews or direct observation. This dashboard provides information on displacement which occurred on 11 July 2020 in one village of Lac Province.

SUMMARY OF EVENT



With insecurity growing on the islands of Lake Chad, **40 households (209 individuals)** preventively left the village of **Tetewa**, located in the sous-préfecture of **Kangalam (Mamdi** département). These individuals took refuge in the village of **Ngororom**, located in the **Bol** sous-préfecture, in the same département.


