

CHAD — EMERGENCY TRACKING TOOL (ETT)



Assessment conducted through phone interviews with key informants The objective of the Emergency Tracking Tool (ETT) is to collect information on large and sudden population movements. Information is collected through key informant interviews or direct observation. This dashboard provides information on displacement which took place on 8 and 10 January 2021 in two sites of Lac Province.

SUMMARY OF EVENT

→ DISPLACED POPULATION : 434 Internally Displaced Persons, 108 Households (estimates)

Following an armed attack which occurred on 25 December 2020 in the Kangalam sous-préfecture (Mamdi département):

- On 8 January 2021, 17 households (52 individuals) fled the villages of Bikerom and Maria located on the islands of Lake Chad (Kangalam sous-préfecture, Mamdi département) for the site of Bibi Barrage located on the mainland, in the same sous-préfecture (this site is administratively part of the Kangalam sous-préfecture, although it is geographically located in the Bol sous-préfecture).
- On 10 January 2021, 91 households (382 individuals) fled the villages of Maria and Choua located on the islands of Lake Chad (Kangalam sous-préfecture, Mamdi département) for the site of Koudoukolé located on the mainland (Bol sous-préfecture, Mamdi département).


This attack had already triggered the displacement of 301 households who took refuge in the Baga-Sola sous-préfecture on 4 January 2021 (see <u>ETT report #90</u>) and according to key informants, other individuals are planning to flee the Kangalam sous-préfecture for the Bibi Barrage or the Koudoukolé site in the coming days.
