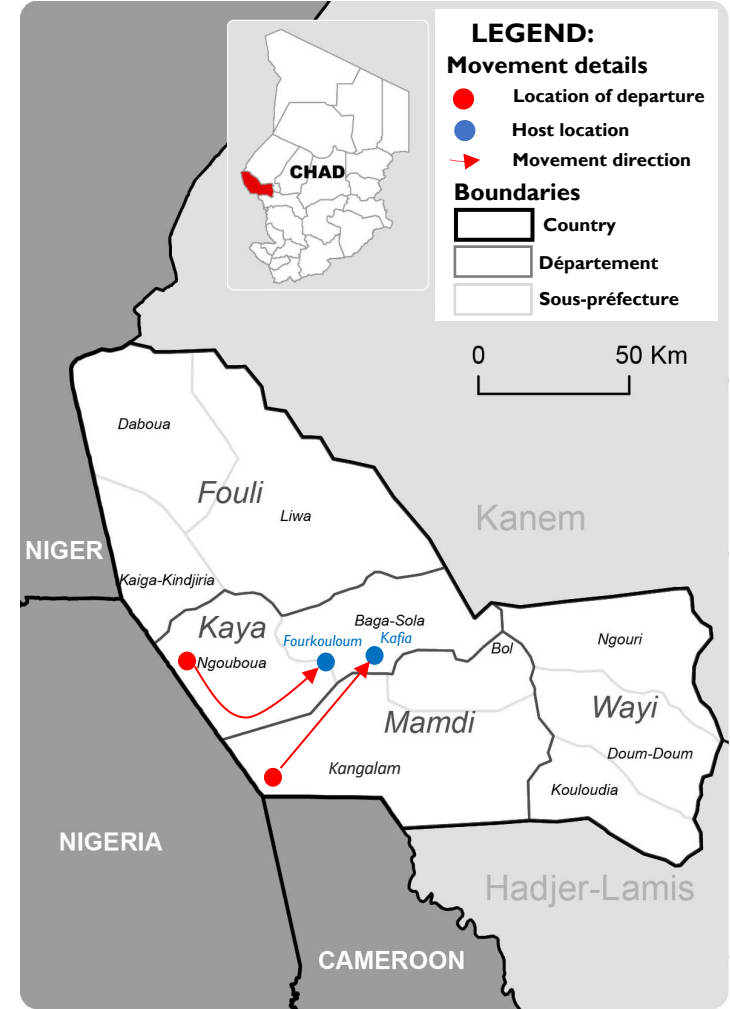

SUMMARY OF EVENT

DISPLACED POPULATION : 1,703 Internally Displaced Persons, 350 Households (estimates)

On **28 January 2021** :

- With **insecurity growing in Lac Province** and due to the **lack of humanitarian assistance**, **300 households (1,500 individuals)** preventively fled the site of **Kaya I (Ngouboua sous-préfecture, Kaya département)** for the site of **Fourkouloum**, located in the same sous-préfecture.
- Following an **armed attack** which occurred on **28 January 2021**, **50 households (203 individuals)** fled the village of **Diguindom** located on the islands of Lake Chad (**Kangalam sous-préfecture, Mamdi département**) for the site of **Kafia** located on the mainland (**Baga-Sola sous-préfecture, Kaya département**).
