

## Overall returnees through **Torkham and Chaman** since January 2020 **5,768**

For this reporting period **1,155** interviews were conducted comprising of the following categories

- 95.9%** \*Undocumented families
- 3.6%** \*Undocumented individuals travelling with documented families
- 0.5%** \*Undocumented individuals travelling alone

\* Interviews were conducted at both transit points, Torkham and Chaman/Spin Boldak

- 80%** Individuals with no documents  
Afghans who do not have any legal document (POR, ACC, VISA)
- 3%** Individuals with ACC  
Individuals with Afghan Citizen Card (ACC)
- 16%** Individuals with Tazkira  
Afghan ID card that comes under the Undocumented Afghans category
- 0%** Individuals with ACC Token  
Individuals who received token to obtain ACC
- 1%** Individuals with Expired POR Card  
Proof of Registration (POR) cards that have expired before 2015
- 0%** Individuals with no Passport or Expired Visa  
Afghans with expired visa or passport without visa

### WHO IS AN UNDOCUMENTED AFGHAN

- Individuals with No Documents
- Individuals with No Passport or Lapsed Visa
- Individuals with Tazkira
- Individuals with Expired POR Card

**1,146** individuals returned through the **Torkham border** and **4,622** individuals returned through the **Chaman/Spin Boldak border**. Out of these returnees, border authorities facilitated the return of 307 individuals who returned through Torkham and 187 who returned through Chaman due to the unavailability of legal documentation to remain in Pakistan. Therefore, analysis for 494 individuals is not available in this report.

Overall **11%** individuals were identified as vulnerable during this reporting period

- 89%** of vulnerable cases
- 44%** Elderly Members
- 5%** Disabled Persons
- 31%** Chronically ill persons
- 6%** Pregnant Women
- 0%** Female Headed Households
- 14%** \*Widows + Other

Other Categories includes 2% Mentally ill and 1% Widow.

### TRANSPORT & ASSETS

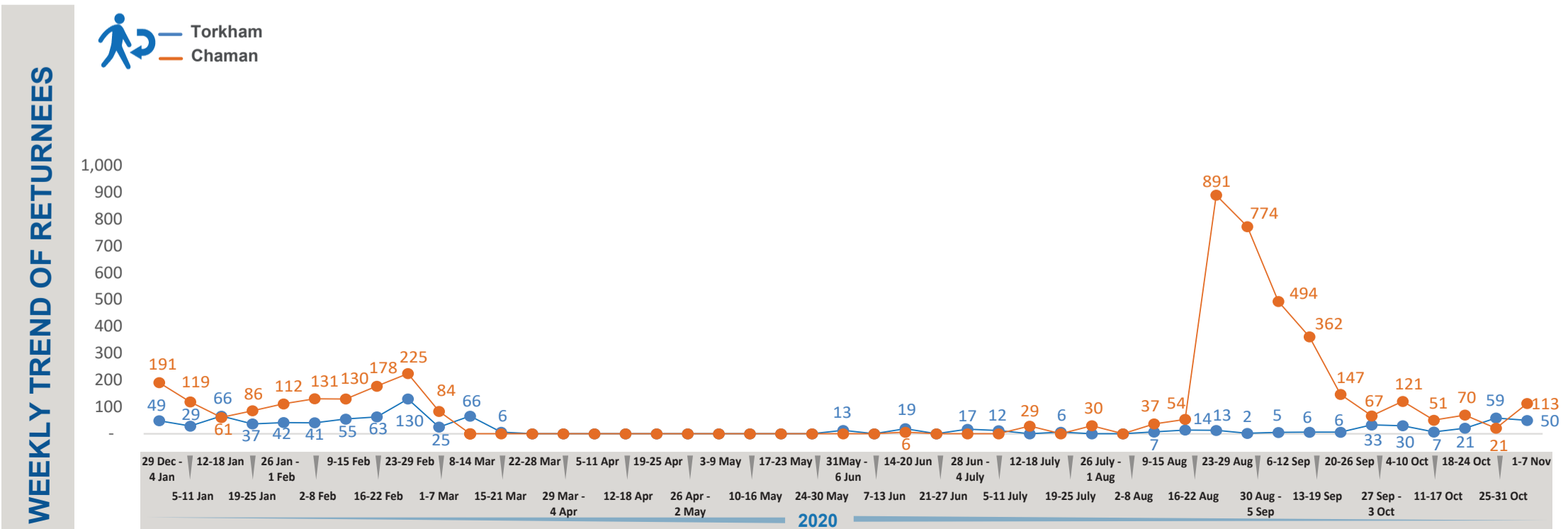
Overall, **1,155** vehicles crossed over the **Torkham and Chaman/Spin Boldak borders** during the reporting period. The majority of returnees used **pick-ups and trucks (44% and 29% respectively)** to return to Afghanistan. **Cash and household items** were reported as the highest priority assets for migrants returning to Afghanistan.
