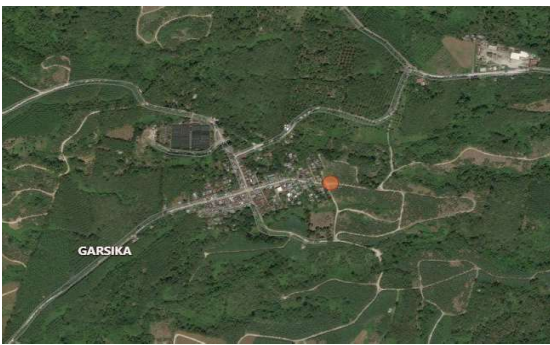

REASONS PREVENTING RETURN OF IDPs

House damaged/destroyed, lack of safety, fear of earthquakes destroying further their houses

The Department of Education mandates that schools can only be used as evacuation centers for a maximum of 15 days. Medium- to long-term site infrastructure is not advisable for these types of sites at the moment. Relocation options need to be found for IDPs in these types of sites. Classes are resuming in this site soon despite the school being unavailable for use. Classes will be held outside in temporary learning spaces outdoors.
