



IOM works with national and local authorities in order to gain a better understanding of population movements throughout West and Central Africa. To that end, it has set up Flow Monitoring Points (FMPs) to quantify and qualify migration flows, trends and routes, at key entry, transit or exit points. Furthermore, FMPs gather qualitative information on travelers profiles, countries of provenance and intended destinations and modes of transport.

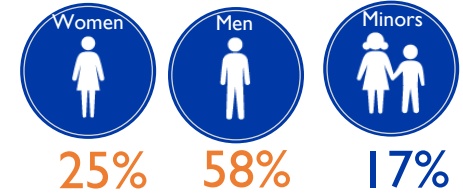
During **Flow Monitoring Registry (FMR)** exercises, enumerators collect data on the numbers, provenance, destinations and basic demographic information of travelers transiting through FMPs.

In Burkina Faso, Flow Monitoring is conducted at key transit points in Ouagadougou since 2017, as well as in Dori/Seytenga, Kantchari, Faramana and Yendéré since 2018.

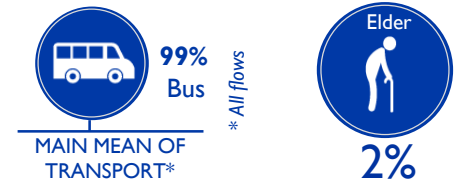

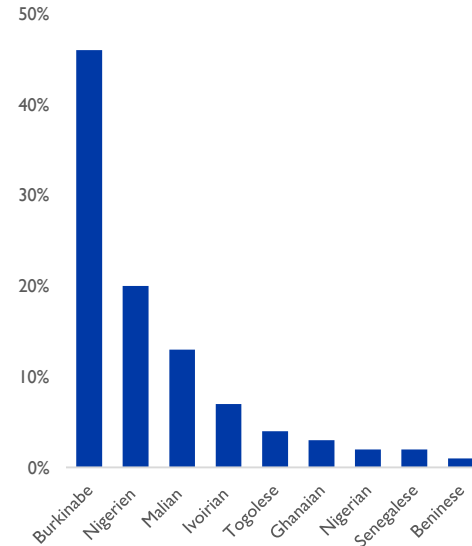
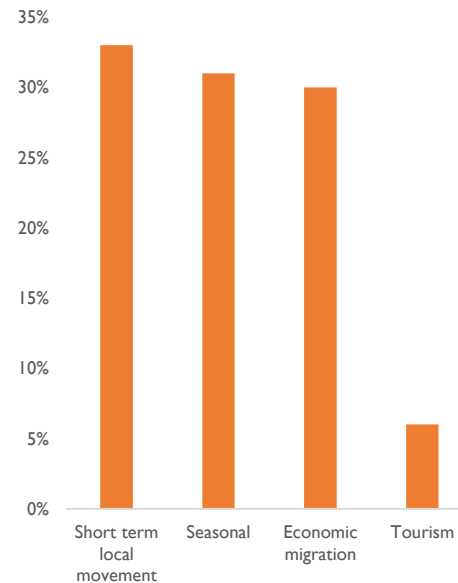

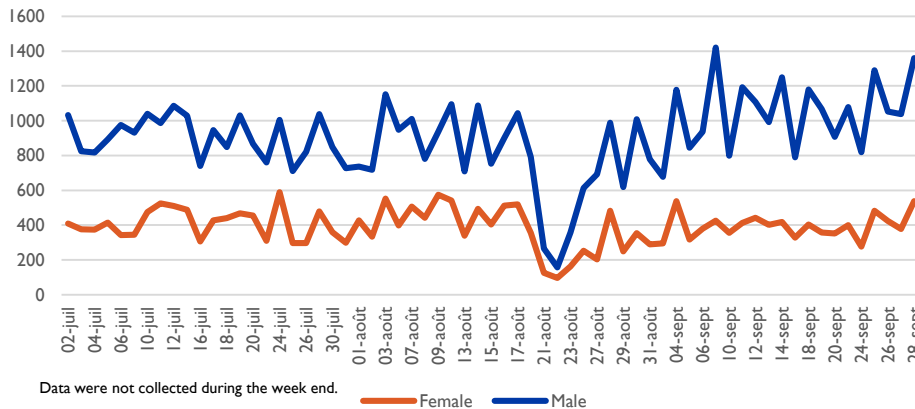
MAIN TYPES OF MOBILITY OBSERVES

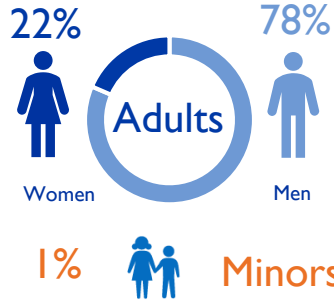

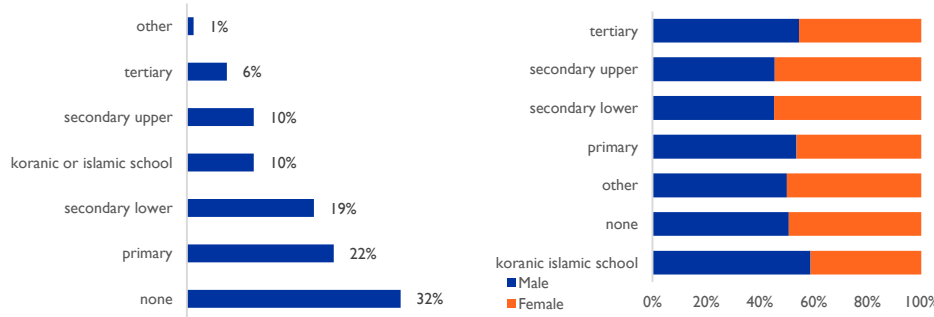


TYPE OF TRAVEL INTENDED

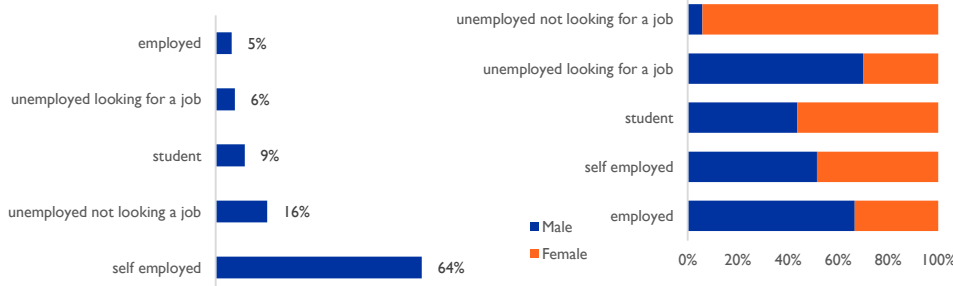


Cross-border travel: Respondents whose country of final intended destination is different from their country of departure.
Internal travel: When respondents intend to travel within the same country.

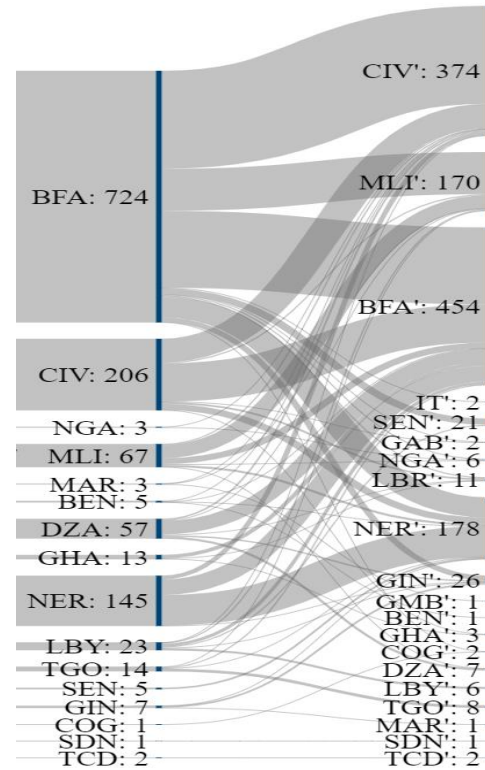

DEPARTURE & INTENDED DESTINATION COUNTRIES*



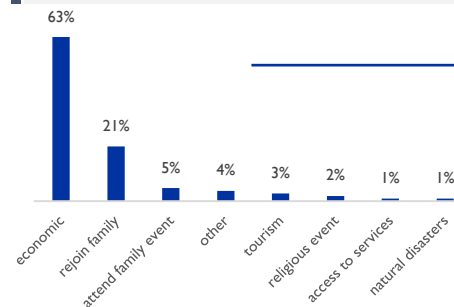
LENGTH OF JOURNEY TO DATE
