

Summary

Askira/Uba (Triggers: improved security, voluntary

relocation, poor living condition): 175 new arrivals and 11 departures were recorded in Askira/Uba during the reporting period. These include 153 individuals (INDs) who returned to Askira/Uba from Adamawaw State, 15 INDs who returned from Akko in Gombe State, 7 INDs who arrived at Ngohi ward of Askira/Uba from nearby Anguwan Gabar village and 11 INDs who left for Hong LGA.

Bama (Triggers: voluntary relocation, military operation):

131 INDs arrived at Bama and 18 INDs left Bama during the reporting period. These include 74 arrivals at Banki Camp, 57 arrivals at General Hospital Camp, 14 departures from General Hospital Camp and 4 departures from Banki Camp.

Chibok (Trigger: voluntary relocation):

19 INDs left Chibok for Gumsuri/Misakurbudu ward of Damboa LGA.

Damboa (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living condition):

26 INDs arrived at Damboa during the reporting period. These include 13 arrivals at Abori Camp and 13 arrivals at Damboa Central community.

Dikwa (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 46 INDs arrived at Dikwa 20-Housing Estate from Gulumba ward of Bama LGA

(24 INDs) and Mudu/Kaza ward of Damboa LGA (22 INDs).

Gubio (Triggers: poor living condition, attack): 25 INDs arrived at Gubio and 4 INDs left Gubio during the reporting period. These include 16 INDs who arrived at Bula Karaye community from neighboring Abatcari village, 9 INDs who returned to Alkaleri from Maiduguri M.C. LGA and 4 INDs who left Alkaleri for Mobbar LGA.

Gwoza (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living condition): 449 INDs arrived at Gwoza during the reporting period. These include 333 INDs who returned to Gadamayo community from Mubi-South in Adamawa State, 58 INDs who returned to Gadamayo from Jere LGA, 48 INDs who arrived at Wege Arrival Centre from Pulka/Bokko in Gwoza and 10 INDs who arrived at Wege Arrival Centre from Bama LGA.

Konduga (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living condition): 9 INDs arrived at Konduga and 18 INDs left Konduga during the reporting period. These include 9 INDs who arrived at Boarding School Camp Konduga, 4 INDs who left Boarding School Camp for Lauro community in Konduga and 14 INDs who left Federal Training Centre Camp for Bama LGA.

Kukawa (Triggers: improved security, voluntary relocation, poor living condition): 78 INDs arrived at Kukawa town during the reporting period. These include 40 INDs who arrived at Krikasamma community from Maiduguri M.C. LGA, 23 INDs who arrived at Tsohon Kasuwa from Kebbi State, 11 INDs who arrived at Yoberi community from Maiduguri M.C. and 4 INDs who arrived at Ajari from Monguno LGA.

Lamurde (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 11 INDs left Arhan Kunu/Gima community in Larmurde for Askira/Uba LGA in Borno State.

Madagali (Triggers: voluntary relocation, attack): 63 INDs arrived at Madagali town from surrounding wards and 26 INDs left the town for Gwoza LGA in Borno State.

Mafa (Trigger: poor living condition): 36 INDs arrived at Mafa during the reporting period. These include 22 INDs who arrived at Government Girls Secondary School (GGSS) Camp from surrounding villages and 14 INDs who arrived at Mafa Primary School Camp from Jere LGA.

Michika (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 11 INDs arrived at Buppa community in Michika and 13 INDs left Kubureshosho community for Askira/Uba LGA in Borno State.

Monguno (Triggers: voluntary relocation, poor living condition): 48 INDs arrived at Monguno during the reporting period. These include 25 INDs who arrived at Fulatari Camp and 23 INDs who arrived at Government Secondary School (GSS) Camp.

Mubi-North (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 4 INDs arrived at Wuro Gude community from Minawaul in Mubi-South LGA.

Mubi-South (Trigger: poor living condition): 124 INDs left Mubi-South during the reporting period. These include 118 INDs who left Wuropatuje/Tudun Wada for Gwoza town and 6 INDs who left Anguwan Kara for Lagos.

Ngala (Trigger: voluntary relocation): 40 INDs arrived at International School Camp Ngala. 25 INDs arrived from surrounding wards, while 15 INDs arrived from Kala Balge LGA.
