





Bama, Chibok, Damboa, Dikwa, Gwoza, Kaga, Kala Balge, Konduga, Kukawa, Mafa, Monguno, Ngala, Mubi South and Michika



Location Movement

- Eocation Provement		
STATE: Borno LGA: Bama	79 individuals (INDs) arrived at Bama during the reporting period. These include 52 INDs who arrived at General Hospital Camp from Abbaram ward in Bama due to an attack in Abbaram, 5 INDs who voluntarily returned to Banki Camp from Minawu Camp in Mokolo, Cameroon, 20 INDs who arrived at Banki Camp from Gulumba ward of Bama and 2 INDs who arrived at Banki Camp from Dallori Camp II in Konduga LGA. Needs include food, shelter and NFIs.	
STATE: Borno LGA: Chibok	27 INDs arrived at Chibok during the reporting period. These include 22 INDs who arrived at Bla Audu from Nchiha in Chibok and 5 INDs who arrived at Bayan Kasuwa, from Korongilum B in Chibok.	
STATE: Borno LGA: Damboa	57 INDs arrived at Damboa during the reporting period. These include 42 INDs who arrived at Central Primary School Camp from Kafa/Mafi ward of Damboa, 4 INDs who arrived at Abori Gate Camp from Yejiwa ward of Konduga LGA and 11 INDs who arrived at Damboa town from Manguzu. The new arrivals are currently being screened by the military.	
STATE: Borno LGA: Dikwa	81 INDs arrived at Dikwa 20-Housing Unit Camp during the reporting period. These include 38 INDs who arrived at the Camp from Gulumba ward of Bama LGA, 10 INDs who arrived at the Camp from Auno/Chabbol ward of Konduga LGA, 26 INDs who arrived at the Camp from Zangeri ward of Bama LGA, 5 INDs who arrived at the Camp from Muna Area of Dusuman ward in Jere LGA and 2 INDs who arrived at the Camp from Boboshe ward of Dikwa LGA. Food and health assistance is being provided by humanitarian partners. Other needs include shelter and NFIs.	
STATE: Borno LGA: Gwoza	495 INDs arrived at Gwoza during the reporting period. These include 260 INDs who returned to Gwoza town from Bale Galtimari ward of Jere LGA, 156 INDs who returned to Gwoza town from Kwahifa ward of Mubi South in Adamawa State, 43 INDs who arrived at Pulka Transit Camp from neighboring villages in Gwoza, 14 INDs who arrived at Pulka Transit Camp from Mubi in Adamawa State and 22 INDs who arrived at Pulka Transit Camp from Banki in Bama LGA. Needs include food, shelter, water and NFIs.	
STATE: Borno LGA: Kaga	6 INDs arrived at Benisheikh in Kaga during the reporting period. These include 3 INDs who arrived from Wajiro ward of Kaga due to fear of an attack and 3 INDs who arrived from Shishimari in Konduga LGA as a result of military operation.

STATE: Borno LGA: Kala Balge	35 INDs arrived at Rann "A" in Kala Balge during the reporting period. These include 22 INDs who arrived from Mudu ward of Dikwa LGA, 8 INDs who arrived from Jarawa ward of Kalabalge and 5 INDs who arrived from Mudu ward of Dikwa LGA.
STATE: Borno LGA: Konduga	64 INDs arrived at Konduga and 2 INDs departed from Konduga during the reporting period. These include 22 INDs who arrived at Boarding Primary School Camp from Kanari Yale ward of Konduga LGA, 42 INDs who arrived at the Camp from Dangala, Yale ward of Konduga LGA and 2 INDs who left Dalori II Camp to Banki Camp in Bama.
STATE: Borno LGA: Kukawa	49 INDs returned to Kukawa during the reporting period. These include 24 INDs who returned to Kukawa from Bolori 1 in Maiduguri M.C. and 24 INDs who returned to Kukawa from Gomari ward of Jere LGA. The movements were due to the improved security situation in Kukawa.
STATE: Borno LGA: Mafa	6 INDs arrived at Mafa Camp A from Musari Muna, Dusuman ward of Jere LGA.
STATE: Borno LGA: Monguno	19 INDs arrived at Monguno and 18 INDs left Monguno during the reporting period. These include 6 INDs who arrived at Government Day Secondary School (GDSS) Camp from Bolori 2 in Maiduguri M.C., 4 INDs who arrived at GDSS Camp from Cross in Kukawa, 9 INDs who arrived at Government Senior Science Secondary School Camp from Kukawa LGA, 13 INDs who left Gana Ali camp to Kekeno in Kukawa LGA and 5 INDs who left GDSS Camp Monguno to Gamboru ward of Maiduguri M.C. LGA.
STATE: Borno LGA: Ngala	349 INDs arrived at International School Camp Ngala during the reporting period. These include 70 INDs who arrived at the Camp from Fotokol in Cameroon, 32 INDs who arrived at the Camp from Gulumba ward of Bama LGA, and 247 INDs who arrived at the Camp from villages in neighbouring wards of Ngala LGA. Needs include food, shelter, NFIs and health support.
STATE: Adamawa LGA: Mubi South	29 INDs arrived at Mubi South in Adamawa from Borno and 121 INDs departed Mubi South during the reporting period.
STATE: Adamawa LGA: Michika	184 INDs arrived at Michika during the reporting period. These include 49 INDs who returned to Michika from Taraba state, 63 INDs who returned from Girei ward of Adamawa state, 13 INDs who arrived from Cameroon, 11 INDs who returned from Anguwan Rukuba in Platue State and 48 INDs who returned from Yola.
